

Hope at Home: Empowering Immigrant Families. A compassionate investment for leaders.

The Situation

- 1. Parents living in fear
- 2. Parents unable to provide safely
- 3. Families hiding at home afraid of ICE raids
- 4. Lack of digital skills prevents "work from home" (digital jobs)





The current solution is only short-term (below)

- Food delivered to immigrant families
- 2. Immigrants receive help with rent and utility payments
- 3. Immigrants receive delivery of non-food items, diapers, soap.

We need a longterm solution.

- 1. ICE raids are not ending.
- 2. ICE raids are increasing.
- 3. With over three years remaining in their term, the current administration can continue conducting raids for the foreseeable future.
- 4. We can expect raids and deportations for at least 3 more years (maybe more)
- 5. What is our long-term solution?



Solution: Immigrants will learn new skills.

(1) Where will they learn?

In the safety of their own home.

(2) What will they learn?

Digital skills (how to use the computer, how to use E-mail, and how to use the Internet).

(3) Who will teach them?

They will watch online training videos. The training is self-paced so they can go as fast or as slow and repeat the videos as many times as they need (anytime day or night.)



What about signing up, lists, and webcams. Can't they be tracked?

- 1. The training is anonymous.
- 2. No sign up.
- 3. No webcam.
- 4. No driving required.
- 5. Learn at home.
- 6. This training provides safe, remote work opportunities and provides dignity, stability, and hope



Why Community Leaders Must Support This

- Strengthens neighborhoods and economy
- 2. Empowers families to contribute safely
- 3. A compassionate investment in our future
- 4. Long-term strategy for safe, "work from home" employment and possible citizenship

How does this work? Only 3 steps

Step 1:

Your organization donates.

Step 2:

Flyers are created that contain information about the training (instructions, website, username, password, etc.)

Step 3:

As volunteers deliver groceries and nonfood items to immigrant homes and to the community, the volunteers leave the flyer with the family. That's it. Immigrants read the flyer, watch the online videos in the safety of their home and create skills and new hope.
