### GROWING IN FAITH THROUGH ROOTED

As the first churchwide session of Rooted came to a close, groups gathered to celebrate what God had done through worship, testimonies and baptisms. This fall, 272 adults took part in Rooted groups, with an additional 83 children participating in Rooted Crew (birth-5th grade) and 85 students in Student Life.

Joining Rooted was a big step for Alex and her husband. "We didn't know many people from the church," Alex shares. "I was worried who we would get matched up with in the group. If we didn't get along or 'click' with other couples, it could be awkward or hinder the experience."

Those fears quickly faded. "Right from the beginning, most people got surprisingly honest," Alex said. "I knew if it was starting that way, when we didn't even know each other's names, it was going to be a good experience."

Over the next several weeks, Alex entered into a time of profound personal growth and spiritual rhythms. "I have made a new commitment to spend time with God every day," she noted. "My husband and I started doing the guiet time together every night, discussing the readings and questions. We've talked about things for the first time in our 11 years of marriage. It's not only bringing me closer to God, but closer to my husband as well."

Alex's story is just one of many from Rooted. We're excited to see how God continues to work in the days and years ahead.
