



Performance Charolais Bulls

Rank these bulls to be used in a seedstock operation in eastern Colorado where they will be run exclusively on heifers for the next two breeding seasons. These heifers calve in large pastures starting in late April and are offered limited assistance during calving. As such, this operation puts extra emphasis on calving ease and low maintenance females. Bulls are sold privately to local producers, but lately this operation has started selling large groups of bred heifers that top the market. As a result, the majority of females born will be bred and retained in herd or marketed to make cows.
