Performance Angus Bulls

Rank these bulls as they should be selected in a purebred Angus program located in south-central Nebraska. These bulls will be mated to both cows and heifers with the idea of generating productive, rugged bull progeny along with maternal, low input females. The main revenue source of this operation is the marketing of purebred bulls and bred heifers through two annual production sales. All cull progeny are fed-out at the family owned feed yard and marketed on a dual-based grid.

Labor and feed resources are adequate.
