November 2025 Hereford Heifers

Evaluate and rank the following Hereford heifers based on their potential as replacement females for a purebred Hereford program in the Flint Hills of Kansas. This operation generates the majority of its revenue through marketing Hereford bulls to commercial cattlemen. Their customers primarily maintain Angus-influenced cow herds and keep roughly 20% of their heifers for replacement purposes. All other heifers and all steers are finished through retained ownership and sold on the rail.
