MEMORANDUM OF TELEPHONE CONVERSATION

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Telephone Conversation with
King Hussein of Jordan

DATE, TIME June 12, 1989, 3:15 - 3:16 pm
AND PLACE: Air Force One

King Hussein telephoned the President aboard Air Force One to present him birthday greetings.

After an exchange of pleasantries, King Hussein stated that he was calling to wish the President a very happy birthday. The President replied that it was very thoughtful of the King, and that being 65 years old does not hurt a bit.

King Hussein stated that Queen Noor also sends her love. The President asked if the King was in Amman, to which King Hussein replied in the affirmative.

The President stated that it was very nice of the King to call and indicated that he (the President) had delivered a big environmental message.

After an exchange of courtesies, the call was terminated.
