MEMORANDUM OF TELEPHONE CONVERSATION

SUBJECT: Telcon with President Guillermo Endara of Panama on June 11, 1992 (Ø)

AND PLACE: Air Force One

The President: Mr. President, can you hear me okay? (U)

President Endara: Yes, Mr. Bush. I can hear you fine. (U)

The President: I am calling to say thank you for a wonderful visit. Please don't worry about that little incident at the Plaza. It was a wonderful visit, and we had a very warm reception. I don't want you to worry about that incident caused by a handful of people. (Ø)

President Endara: Thank you very much. I was worried about what you would think because we appreciate your visit -- we in Panama love you and we are glad that you came. So I thank you very much. (Ø)

The President: Barbara and I have been talking about the visit since we left. It was a wonderful, warm reception and 30 people can't spoil it. I hope that the Panamanian people heard some of my speech at the base because I talked about how much you have done to restore democracy. I want them to know that we had a good visit. So let's not let that incident bother us. I would be delighted to come back to Panama anytime. (Ø)

President Endara: Yes, we heard your speech -- it was broadcast on Panamanian television. It was a wonderful speech, and we thank you very much for your kind words. Everyone heard it, and heard that you were pleased. Give my love to your wife. We would be happy to welcome you back anytime. (Ø)

The President: Well, I want to thank you again, and just one more thing. You don't happen to have the Mayor's number? I am worried about her. She and her people worked so hard, and I want to tell her personally that I think the visit went well. It was a wonderful reception, and I want to give her a call. We are grateful, and I want to thank her. (Ø)

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President Endara: Yes, I will get it for you. Her number is 64-15-46. (U)

The President: Okay. Thank you very much. I will give her a call. It was a wonderful time. We enjoyed it very much. (U)

President Endara: Thank you. You are always welcome to come back anytime. Good bye. (U)

The President: Good bye. (U)
