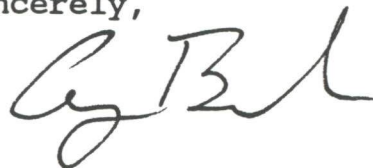
Dear Mr. Norton:

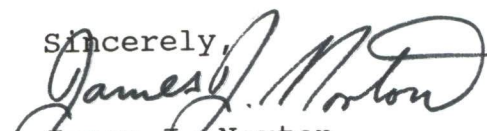
We have, from time-to-time, differed with the Bush Administration on the way Administration policies affect the working people in the United States.
