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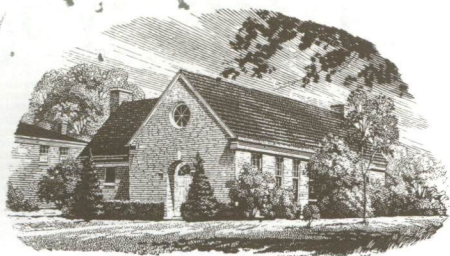

Dear President Bush:

We, the Chicago Monthly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers), wish to encourage our government to pursue all available peaceful means to maintain peace in the Mid-east. We are appreciative of your resistance to the voices calling for violent response and blood-shed.

We endorse the use of ^anon-combatant United Nations peace-keeping presence to achieve stability in the Iraq-Kuwait-Saudi Arabia unrest. Further, we seek the voluntary withdrawal of U.S. forces from the region. Finally, we urge that all persons in the area be treated with equal fairness.

We believe there are peaceful alternatives in international situations that appear to call for force and ask that you continue to seek them out.

We pray that our government will exercise restraint from the use of force and that our leaders will find the creative resources needed to achieve peace through diplomacy.

In the knowledge that through God's grace all things are possible, we write to you.
