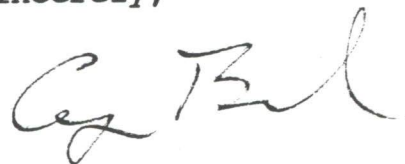
Dear Ms. Shaw:
