While our nation and the world are understandably in a period of stress and uncertainty, I want to express to you my sincere admiration for the leadership and wisdom you continue to demonstrate in the most important job on this planet.

I congratulate you with enthusiasm for your steadfast support of those millions with disability in the U. S. throughout the difficult negotiations and negatives from even some of your most dedicated friends, when you finally were able to sign the ADA legislation. I was among those who attended the ceremony on the White House lawn, and I will never forget the happy and radiant faces I saw on that occasion. I know it was never easy, but I believe that in a very few years it will prove a blessing for the entire nation.

Your strong and determined leadership in the Gulf crisis surely averted what would otherwise have been a takeover of most of the world's oil supply with the immediate result of making most of the world an economic hostage to Saddam's thieving dictatorship.
