Dear President Bush,

I am writing to express my opposition to the pursuit of a military resolution of the current conflict in the Middle East. As the Provincial Leader of the Baltimore Province of the School Sisters of Notre Dame, I am a member of the Leadership Conference of Women Religious in the United States. I am in full support of their recent statement and rationale for opposing current U.S. policy. I quote our rationale in full:

"As women religious committed to actions that enhance the quality of life on our planet and the quality of relationships among all peoples, we cannot support aggressive movements which threaten to widen differences and increase the scope of violence already perpetrated. We believe that increased military activity in the Persian Gulf deflects attention from our failure to develop a national energy policy, from the S and L scandal and the increasing budget deficit. Such action diverts resources from urgent domestic needs such as housing, health care, education and environmental issues."

The School Sisters of Notre Dame of the Baltimore Province are 502 sisters involved in educational ministries primarily in the states of Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, the District of Columbia and the countries of Nigeria, El Salvador, Honduras, and Bolivia. We also have sisters working in the states of California, Indiana, Kentucky, Mississippi, Missouri, Connecticut, New York, Ohio, South Dakota, Tennessee, Wisconsin and in Germany and Italy.

You have the power to remove United States Armed Forces before more lives are lost in this conflict and I urge you to do so immediately.
