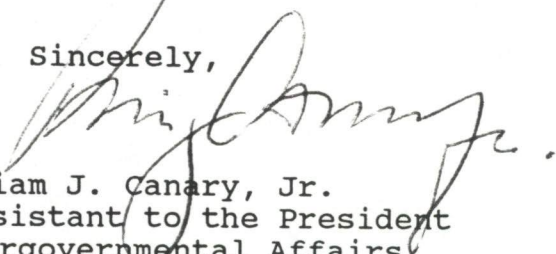
Dear Mrs. DeMatte:

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND EXPRESSING CONCERN FOR THE POLITICAL HOSTAGES, THE ARMED FORCES AND ALL RESERVE AND NATIONAL GUARD UNITS INVOLVED IN THE CRISIS IN THE PERSIAN GULF.

WHEREAS, during these difficult times all Americans are expressing concern for the political hostages, the armed forces, the Reserve and National Guard Units that are serving in the Persian Gulf crisis; and

WHEREAS, Maria Seda, a resident of the City of Vineland, who is the mother of Magdalena Al-Mughrabi^{NOTED}, an American Citizen now living in Kuwait; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena Al-Mughrabi, her husband Suleiman Al-Mughrabi and their three children are being held as political hostages in Kuwait as a result of the crisis in the Persian Gulf; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland and the residents of our community are concerned for the safety of Magdalena and her family and all other people who are being held as political hostages in Kuwait and Iraq; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland and the residents of our community are also concerned for the welfare of our United States military troops and other armed forces from other countries that are serving their country in these turbulent times; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland would like the political hostages and the members of all the armed forces represented by various countries to know that we are concerned and are praying for their safe return; and

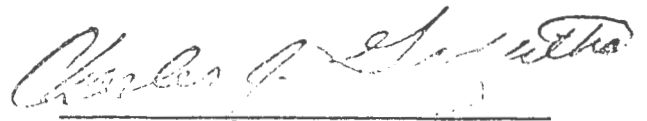
WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Vineland would like to express their support to the President of the United States and members of Congress for their decision in engaging in both an economic and military effort against Iraq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that as a symbol of concern for the safe return of these political hostages, particularly Magdalena Al-Mughrabi and her family, that each resident of the City of Vineland and surrounding communities display their concern by wearing a yellow ribbon, or by hanging a yellow ribbon on his or her front door or by tying a yellow ribbon on the antenna of his or her car; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that as a symbol of support and concern for all the armed forces that are serving in the Middle East, and in particular the United States' troops and all Reserve and National Guard Units, that all residents of this City fly the American flag everyday until all participants and hostages are returned safely to their native country; and

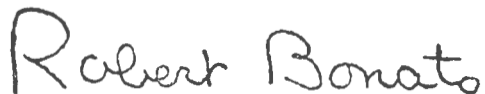
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be sent to the President of the United States, the Honorable James Florio, Governor of the State of New Jersey, Congressman William Hughes, Senators Frank Lautenberg and William Bradley, Senator James Cafiero, Assemblymen Frank LoBiondo and Edward Salmon and to the family of Magdalena Al-Mughrabi as a sign of our support and prayers during the Persian Gulf crisis.
