Dear George:

While we are encouraged by Israel's initiative on the hostage issue, we believe that a successful Middle East peace conference is of overriding importance to the United States and to the people of that troubled region, both Arabs and Israelis. All considerations should be subordinate to that end.

As President Bush explained in his news conference Thursday, September 12, a significant problem has arisen. On the eve of the conference, Israel has requested quick congressional approval of \$10 billion in loan guarantees for immigrant-related housing and other projects.

It is the President's judgment that the peace negotiation will be more successful if consideration of this new Israeli aid package is postponed for 120 days. We believe the President's request is a reasonable and fair one. American public opinion strongly supports his position.

The principal leader in the search for peace in the Middle East is the President, and on this issue we urge that you give him your support.
