Dear President Bush:

Just recently, you sent Secretary Baker to meet with eight Arab governments to seek their endorsement of your peace proposal, for Israel to give up land in exchange for peace.

The eight ministers who accepted your proposal were Egypt, Syria, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Bahrain, United Arab Emirates and Qatar. They called for the end of the Israeli occupation of the Arab territories.

It is easy for Arab monarchs who run their governments off the bullet, not the ballot, to say they agree with America's peace plan, that Israel give up land for peace.

The Secretary of State told these Arab leaders that the United States of America would not recognize Jerusalem as Israel's capital.

In addition, he told President Assad of Syria, who helped coordinate the terrorist attack which killed our Marines in Beirut and who has massacred over 20,000 of his own people, that America would help him get back the Golan Heights, the land over the Galilee where Syria used to bomb and kill Israelis.

President Bush, from the beginning you stated there would be no linkage between the nation of Israel and Saddam getting out of Kuwait. If that is the case, why, within days of declaring the war is over, has there been such a tremendous amount of pressure put upon the Jewish people in Israel.

Mr. President, you have been told by your Secretary of State that Saudi Arabia has changed its position on Israel. How can that be possible when the Commander-in-Chief of the Multi-National Forces, Prince Khalid Bin Sultan Bin Abdul Aziz, told the Egyptian Third Army, "Your war on the 10th of Ramadan was an honorable war that reinforced the Arab dignity and destroyed the Israeli security theory and put an end to the concept of the undefeatable enemy. It changed the military theories and developed tactics."?

President Bush, I was there with Prince Aziz and flew to the Saudi/Kuwaiti border with him when he gave that speech to the Egyptian Third Army. The same army that attacked Israel on Yom Kippur, killing Israelis.

President Bush, please do not try to divide the Bible lands that God Almighty gave to the Jewish people. The day your Secretary of State demanded that Israel give up land for peace, many Israelis died. One precious Jewish woman who had just arrived from Russia, was stabbed to death on that very day.

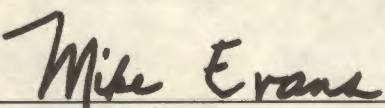

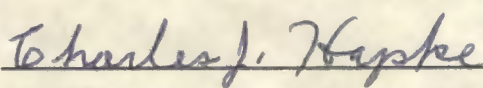
