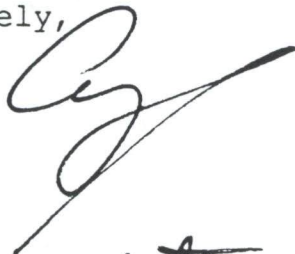
Dear Max:
