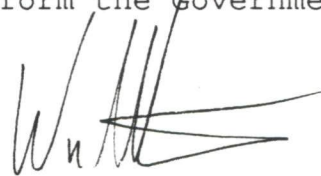

United States

Israel has inquired whether we would agree to the nomination by the Government of Israel of Zalman Shoval as Ambassador to the United States (Tab II). Shoval has a long career in business and politics. He is currently a Lieutenant Colonel (reserve) in the Israeli Army and a member of the Foreign and Security Affairs Committee and the Economics Committee of this Knesset. He is a member of the Likud party. In 1977 he was a member of Israel's delegation to the U.N. General Assembly, and in 1980 he represented the Knesset at the annual meeting of the European Parliament in Strasbourg. In addition to his political activities, Shoval has been active in banking, finance and industry. The Department of State believes that Shoval will make an excellent Ambassador to the United States.

The memorandum to Roy at Tab I indicates that the President agrees to this appointment.

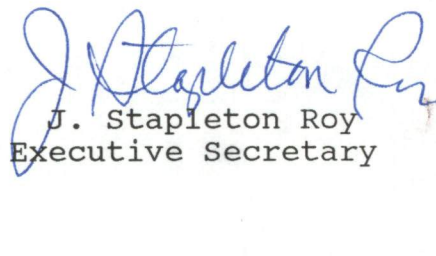

SUBJECT: Appointment of Zalman Shoval of Israel as
Ambassador to the United States

The Government of Israel has inquired whether our Government agrees to the appointment of Zalman Shoval as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Israel to the United States (TAB 2). A biography of Mr. Shoval is attached (TAB 1).

The Department believes from the information available that Mr. Shoval will make an excellent Ambassador to the United States and recommends that the President agree to the proposed appointment. If he concurs, the Department will inform the Government of Israel.
