It is happening again, yes, we the American taxpayers are being black-mailed by Israel and its supporters to guarantee a 10-billion dollar "loan" to resettle the Soviet Jews in Israel, otherwise Israel's Shamir will not come to the peace table to negotiate a critically needed Middle East peace agreement with the Arabs.

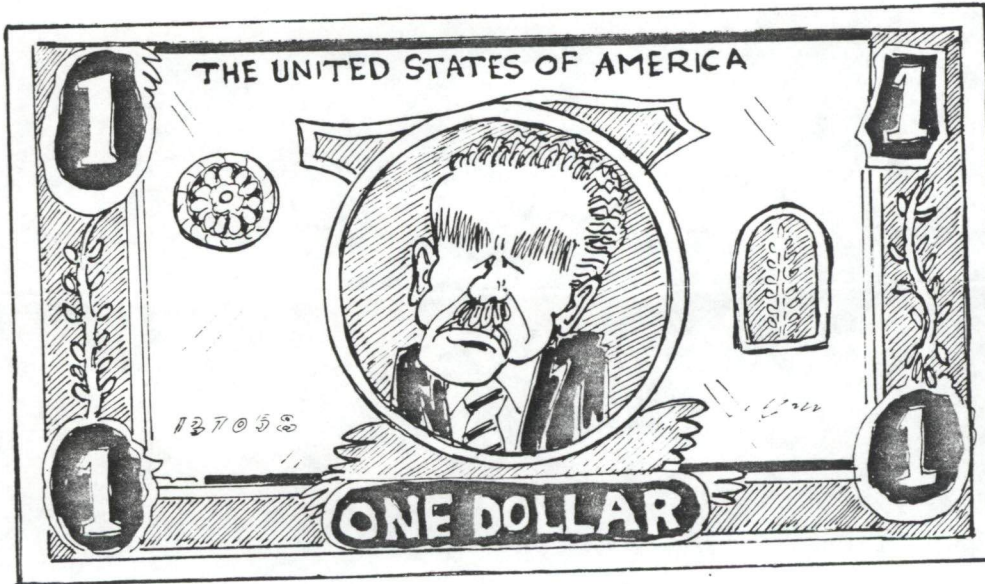
