Dear Mr. Alkhalil:

I am responding to your October 29 message to President Bush regarding the recent upsurge in violence in Lebanon and Israel and the need for U.S. efforts to defuse the situation. The United States shares your deep concern about the escalation of hostilities and is working through diplomatic channels to facilitate an immediate end to the violence.

We have urged the Israeli, Syrian, and Lebanese governments at the highest levels to act with restraint in order to end the hostilities in south Lebanon and Israel. We have underscored the importance of ending Hizbollah's violent challenge to the peace process and to your new government as it moves to increase political and economic security in Lebanon.

The U.S. remains committed to the ongoing Arab-Israeli peace negotiations as the best hope for guaranteeing lasting peace in the region. Despite the recent violence, we expect all parties will continue to negotiate, and that this latest conflict can be defused by the actions of the governments directly involved. I am confident that peace and prosperity can and will return to Lebanon, and I wish you and your colleagues every success in helping to achieve this goal.
