Dear Mr. President:

It has been a week-and-a-half since I was privileged to meet with you in the White House together with a group of clergymen from around the country in one of the most moving experiences in my nearly fifty years in public life.

But the meeting in the White House was not the only moving experience I've had recently. Shortly after our meeting, I traveled to the Soviet Union to participate in a special dedication ceremony of Agudath Israel's brand new office in Moscow, as well as the opening of a new school for Russian Jewish children. You can understand, I'm sure, the depth of my emotion at this extraordinary occasion.

Having now returned from Russia, and having had an opportunity to reflect on the events of the past 11 days, I can't help but juxtapose in my mind my visit to Washington and my visit to Moscow. The common denominator, of course, is the tangible presence of G-d: His presence in the hearts and minds of America and its Commander-in-Chief during the difficult days of the Gulf crisis, His presence in the heart of a Soviet society that for so many years sought to suppress the eternal truth of His omnipotence.

Thank you so much for inviting me to meet with you the other day. Thank you even more for reminding all Americans that we are "one nation, under G-d," whose strength of spirit and purity of faith sustain us through the greatest of national challenges.
