Dear Governor Sununu:

I hope this letter reaches you in good health. From public reports, life seems to be very hectic for you. Individuals that I have had contact with seem to have a very favorable response to the President's actions to date.

I have been approached by the Santa Clara County Republican Party in hopes that I could arrange for you to be a keynote speaker at a major fund raising event sponsored by the local Republican Party. In further discussions, it was agreed to cosponsor the event between the Santa Clara County Republican Party and the local Arab American Community.

The event will have an anticipated ticket price of \$250 per person with ticket sales between 750 - 1,200. The proceeds would be instrumental in helping to finance the on-going voter registration drive and phone banks that have been extremely successful in the last 18 months.

It is our community's intent to create a political action committee. The proceeds would serve as seed money for an on-going trust fund, the interest of which would be used in year to year political activity.
