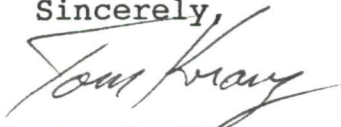

Dear Mr. President:

I wish to respond to the reports discussed in the news today of the Administration's intention to appoint a high-level representative to coordinate the U.S. Government's economic assistance to Poland.

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The Polish American Congress would wholeheartedly support this initiative to designate such an envoy, and would, therefore, like to recommend for your consideration a candidate, Stanley J. Glod, who we feel has the essential qualifications for this unique position.

Allow me to highlight these special qualifications:

- 1) Presently serving as a Presidential appointee, confirmed by the Senate for a second term as Chairman of the Foreign Claims Settlement Commission.
- 2) Of Polish heritage, fluent in Polish, as well as other foreign languages; Active in Polish American organizations over the years, including former president of the Polish National Advocates Society Campaign representative of Polish-Americans for Bush-Quayle.
- 3) Member of the Presidential Advisory Committee for Trade Negotiations (1975-1977), focussing on East European business and including travel to Poland.
- 4) Graduate of the National War College (1980) where the major thesis dealt with Poland's economy in the 1980's.

Undoubtedly, this comprehensive background and experience is most desirable for the position being discussed, and I ask, therefore, your kind consideration of Stanley J. Glod.
