Dear Congresswoman Pelosi:

I am replying on behalf of the President to the letter you and your colleagues sent to him on the eve of the Houston Economic Summit.

By now you are undoubtedly aware of the outcome of the Summit with respect to China. The Political Declaration of the G-7, entitled "Securing Democracy," announced that:

"We acknowledge some of the recent developments in China, but believe that the prospects for closer cooperation will be enhanced by renewed political and economic reform, particularly in the field of human rights. We agree to maintain the measures put into place at last year's Summit, as modified over the course of this year. We will keep them under review for future adjustments to respond to further positive developments in China. For example, in addition to existing lending to meet basic human needs, we will explore whether there are other World Bank loans that would contribute to reform of the Chinese economy, especially loans that would address environmental concerns."

This statement, I believe, goes far in meeting the concerns you expressed and that we share.

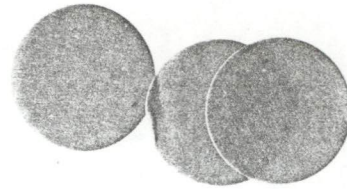

Dear Mr. President:

We are writing to express our concern about a possible softening of the G-7 position against general World Bank lending to the Peoples Republic of China during the upcoming summit in Houston, July 9. In light of the Chinese government's policy of economic recentralization, it is imperative that the G-7 consensus be maintained.

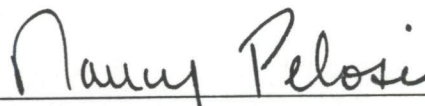
While we understand that the Bank is an economic institution that makes decisions based on economic, rather than political, criteria, there is no doubt that these decisions often have profound political consequences. In the case of China, a resumption of multilateral lending would strengthen those members of the Chinese government who advocate economic centralization and political oppression. Such a resumption would also open the door to bilateral and commercial lending that would further strengthen the Chinese regime.

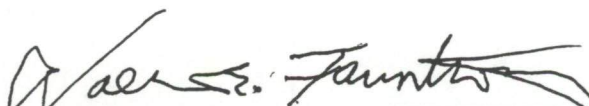
We believe the World Bank should be an instrument of economic and political reform in China. World Bank lending to China should be resumed only after significant economic and political changes have taken place.

We ask that you make every effort to maintain the G-7 consensus against a general resumption of World Bank lending to China until the government there modifies significantly its policy of economic recentralization and political repression.

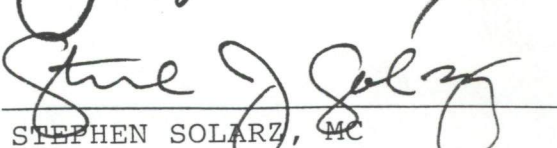

Dear Ms. Pelosi:

I would like to thank you and your many House colleagues for your letter of July 2, 1990, regarding the Houston Summit and World Bank lending to China.

The United States and our major allies have been very successful in sharply reducing and redirecting World Bank lending to China since Tiananmen Square in June 1989. Lending in the World Bank's just concluded fiscal year (WBFY 1990) totalled only \$590 million for five projects. All of these projects were for basic human needs (BHN). This \$590 million lending level compares with a "normal" World Bank lending program to China of \$2-2.5 billion annually. This means we have cut China's lending level by about 75 percent, and have stopped all loans for public sector industry, basic infrastructure, and other non-BHN purposes.

We consulted closely in Houston about developments in China over the past year and on future multilateral development bank (MDB) assistance to China. The consensus view, reflected in the Summit political declaration, was that improvement in relations with China depends upon further evidence that the human rights situation is improving and that structural economic reforms are proceeding in a way to ensure that development assistance is used effectively. For these reasons, Summit participants decided to leave the G-7 consensus as it currently stands, limiting loans to those which serve BHN.

Summit leaders also agreed that, in the context of further positive steps by China, G-7 countries should be willing to explore possibilities for supporting "other World Bank loans that would contribute to reform of the Chinese economy, especially loans that would address environmental concerns."

I share your concerns regarding current economic and political conditions in China. Accordingly, the U.S. will not move beyond supporting BHN loans to China to those contributing to economic reform unless such an approach is warranted by positive actions that China might take in the future.

Dear Mr. President:

We are writing to express our concern about a possible softening of the G-7 position against general World Bank lending to the Peoples Republic of China during the upcoming summit in Houston, July 9. In light of the Chinese government's policy of economic recentralization, it is imperative that the G-7 consensus be maintained.

While we understand that the Bank is an economic institution that makes decisions based on economic, rather than political, criteria, there is no doubt that these decisions often have profound political consequences. In the case of China, a resumption of multilateral lending would strengthen those members of the Chinese government who advocate economic centralization and political oppression. Such a resumption would also open the door to bilateral and commercial lending that would further strengthen the Chinese regime.

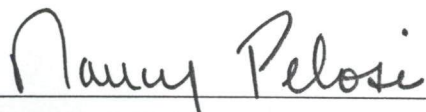
We believe the World Bank should be an instrument of economic and political reform in China. World Bank lending to China should be resumed only after significant economic and political changes have taken place.

We ask that you make every effort to maintain the G-7 consensus against a general resumption of World Bank lending to China until the government there modifies significantly its policy of economic recentralization and political repression.

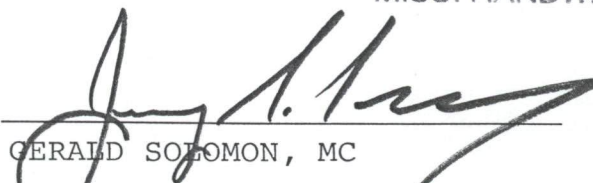
