MR. PRESIDENT:

There are a variety of different views, including some points of disagreement, regarding the attached memo from Clayton Yeutter. The memo is currently being reviewed by NSC and other White House offices. I wanted you to be able to see it, however, in case Clayton calls you about it.

I would urge that you not arrive at any conclusions based on this memo at this time. Timing, for one thing, is a problem, since State is quite concerned that a positive decision on this not be viewed as a quid pro quo for the Soviet vote in the UN Security Council. In addition, OMB, Boskin, Porter, et al. will all have views which they will want considered.

I have discussed this with the Governor, and we are aiming to have a decision package ready for you the week you return from South America.
