1. ISRAEL PUBLIC COUNCIL FOR SOVIET JEWRY (IPCSJ) ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, ELI LANDAU, INFORMED POLOFF ON NOVEMBER 22 THAT THE IPCSJ, WHICH IS SPONSORED BY THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, HAS PROVIDED VICE PREMIER PERES WITH A LIST OF SOVIET JEWISH REFUSENIK CASES TO BE DISCUSSED DURING PERES' PROPOSED MOSCOW VISIT.

2. INCLUDED IN THE LIST ARE:

- ASYA KOGAN, HER TWO SONS DANIEL AND GREGORY, AND HER MOTHER RACHEL MALIS. ASYA'S HUSBAND YAAKOV EMIGRATED ILLEGALLY FROM THE USSR ON JANUARY 29 1989.

- GEORGY BELITSKY. ALTHOUGH BELITSKY'S WIFE AND CHILDREN HAVE BEEN IN ISRAEL SINCE 1987, BELITSKY'S EXIT APPLICATION HAS BEEN REFUSED SINCE 1981.

3. LANDAU BELIEVES THAT, FOR POLITICAL REASONS, PERES WILL NOT PRESS THE ISSUE OF REFUSNIKS WITH THE SOVIETS.

4. LANDAU WILL BE IN THE SOVIET UNION FOR A CONFERENCE OF SOVIET JEWISH LEADERS SPONSORED BY THE SOVIET JEWISH CULTURAL ASSOCIATION FROM DECEMBER

IN VIEW OF YOUR COMING MEETING WITH MR. GORBACHEV, I
URGENTLY WOULD LIKE TO DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO THE
CASE OF DR. GEORGY BELITSKY, A REFUSENIK IN THE
SOVIET UNION WHO IS SEPARATED FROM HIS FAMILY IN
ISRAEL.

IN 1980, MARGARITA AND GEORGY BELITSKY AND THEIR TWO
SONS, VLADIMIR AND CONSTANTIN, FIRST APPLIED FOR EXIT

VISAS TO ISRAEL. FOR MORE THAN SEVEN YEARS THEY WERE
DEPRIVED OF THE RIGHT TO EMIGRATE, ON THE SPURIOUS
GROUNDS OF "REGIME CONSIDERATIONS," BECAUSE OF
GEORGY'S FORMER EMPLOYMENT. SINCE THE FIRST REFUSAL,
GEORGY HAS BEEN TRYING TO PROVE THAT THESE GROUNDS
ARE ABSOLUTELY INVALID.

UNTIL 1979, DR. BELITSKY WORKED AT THE INSTITUTE OF
MECHANICS, WHERE HE DEVELOPED A MEASURING DEVICE WITH
HIGH ACCURACY. THIS DEVICE LATER BECAME THE SUBJECT
OF HIS DOCTORAL DISSERTATION. WHILE DEVELOPING THE
INSTRUMENT, GEORGY HAD CONTACT WITH MANY ENTERPRISES
WHERE HE TESTED HIS INVENTION. A FEW OF THESE

ENTERPRISES WERE MILITARY, AND IN ORDER TO GAIN ENTRY TO THEM A CLEARANCE FORM HAD TO BE OBTAINED.

DR. BELITSKY WAS GIVEN THE LOWEST LEVEL CLEARANCE, WHICH MEANT THAT HE COULD NOT LEAVE THE USSR FOR FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE HIS ACCESS TO SENSITIVE INFORMATION ENDED. HIS SECURITY CLEARANCE ENDED IN 1979.

AT THE END OF 1986, DR. BELITSKY WAS CALLED TO OVIR, THE SOVIET EMIGRATION AND VISA OFFICE, AND TOLD THAT HIS "SECRECY RESTRICTION HAS BEEN REMOVED AND THAT HE COULD REAPPLY. NEVERTHELESS, IN JANUARY 1987, HE WAS ONCE AGAIN DENIED AN EXIT VISA AND INFORMED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO REAPPLY UNTIL THE YEAR

SUBJECT: PERES TO DISCUSS REFUSENIKS WITH SOVIETS 2010. IT IS ABSOLUTELY CLEAR THAT THE CLAIM THAT HE KNOWS STATE SECRETS IS INVALID AS THE RESULTS OF HIS RESEARCH ARE KNOWN THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, AND HIS INVENTIONS HAVE BEEN PATENTED IN VARIOUS WESTERN COUNTRIES.

MORE THAN 10 YEARS HAVE ELAPSED SINCE DR. BELITSKY LEFT THE INSTITUTE OF MECHANICS OF MOSCOW STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE HE HAD THE LOWEST FORM OF SECURITY CLEARANCE.

IN 1987, THE BELITSKY FAMILY MADE THE PAINFUL DECISION TO SEPARATE FOR PURPOSES OF EMIGRATION TO ISRAEL. MARGARITA AND THE TWO SONS ARRIVED IN ISRAEL THAT YEAR. SINCE THEN, GEORGY HAS REMAINED ALONE IN VILNIUS.

IN APRIL 1989, THE MINISTRY OF HIGHER EDUCATION INFORMED HIM BY LETTER THAT SECURITY RESTRICTIONS HAD

SINCE MY HUSBAND'S CASE STILL REMAINS UNRESOLVED, I AM APPEALING TO YOU ONCE AGAIN TO TAKE ALL APPROPRIATE MEASURES TO ENSURE THAT MY HUSBAND WILL BE REUNITED SPEEDILY WITH OUR FAMILY IN ISRAEL.

THE SOVIET MINISTRY OF HIGHER EDUCATION OFFICIALLY INFORMED HIM IN APRIL 1989 THAT SECURITY RESTRICTIONS HAD BEEN LIFTED IN CONNECTION WITH HIS FORMER EMPLOYMENT AT MOSCOW UNIVERSITY, THUS REMOVING OBJECTIONS TO HIS EMIGRATION. NEVERTHELESS HIS REQUEST FOR AN EXIT VISA WAS DENIED JUNE 21, 1989. THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OBJECTED TO HIS DEPARTURE. IN RESPONSE TO DR. GEORGY BELITSKY WAS NEVER EMPLOYED BY THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE. HIS WORK AS A MECHANICAL ENGINEER WAS OF A NON-CLASSIFIED NATURE, AND HIS RESEARCH AND INVENTIONS HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED AND PATENTED IN THE WEST. THEREFORE, THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO VALIDITY NOR JUSTIFICATION TO OFFICIAL ASSERTIONS THAT GEORGY

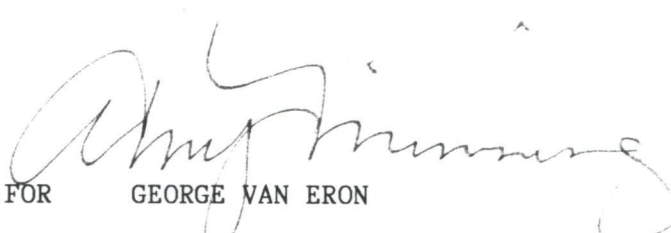
