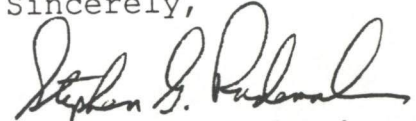

I am honored to accept the chairmanship of THE JOINT COMMISSION of THE JUDEAN HILLS FOUNDATION, charged with the implementation of this project.

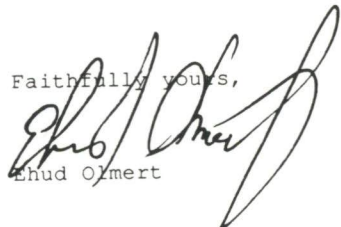

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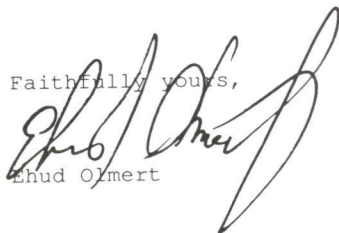
