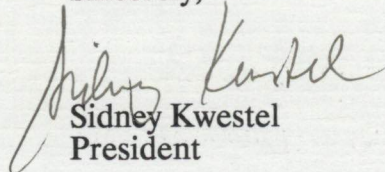
The Orthodox Union is America's most representative synagogue organization with one thousand member congregations across the nation and more than one million individual members. More than one thousand delegates will attend the convention.
