Dear Mr. President:

I returned last night from the 1991 Christian Solidarity Mission to Israel, in which the 120 delegates unanimously adopted the enclosed Proclamation.

This mission drew Christian leaders from across the United States including pastors and theologians from many churches and denominations, past and present leaders of the National Religious Broadcasters Association, Christian and secular media representatives, and American Jewish leaders. We examined the facts on the ground in Israel, throughout all of Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria, and were addressed by major Israeli governmental and private sector leaders.

At our closing session, we drafted the enclosed Proclamation which declares our support for the return of the Jewish People to the Land of Israel as foretold in the Scriptures, and for the \$10 billion in U.S. loan guarantees without extraneous conditions so that Israel may accommodate this massive immigration. The Proclamation recognizes Israel's right to and responsibility for Judea/Samaria (the so-called "West Bank"), Gaza, the Golan Heights, and all of Jerusalem, calls upon the U.S. to desist from pressuring Israel to return these lands and supports the transfer of our U.S. Embassy to Jerusalem, Israel's eternal capital.

We realize that these policies do not reflect conventional State Department thinking. Thus we call upon you expressly to re-examine Israel's and America's interests, to direct the State Department to change its old policies and to incorporate these critical points into your proposed New World Order.

PROCLAMATION
of the August
1991 CHRISTIAN SOLIDARITY MISSION to ISRAEL

We, the 1991 Christian Solidarity Mission to Israel, August 26-29, 1991, hereby declare that:

1. We support the return of the Russian, Ethiopian, and other Diaspora communities to Israel, and we particularly support the provision of \$10 billion in loan guarantees by the United States over the next five (5) years to help Israel house, clothe, feed, educate, and employ these Jewish refugees who are streaming home in hundreds of thousands (soon to be millions) in fulfillment of prophecy; and that these guarantees should not be conditioned upon Israel settlement policies or other extraneous conditions.

2. Israel has the biblical, legal, and strategic right and responsibility to retain sovereignty and control over Judea/Samaria (the so-called "West Bank"), Gaza, the Golan Heights, and especially all of Jerusalem, the eternal capital of Israel, and the United States should desist from pressure upon Israel to relinquish any of these God-given lands.

3. Jerusalem is the eternal and undivided capital of Israel and the United States should place our Embassy there as soon as possible in recognition of that fact.

Adopted unanimously this 28th day of August in Jerusalem, Israel, by the assembled delegates to the 1991 Christian Solidarity Mission to Israel.
