Dear Mr. President:

We are deeply grateful to you for attempting to move the Zionism-racism resolution to the top of the U.N. agenda. Your October speech before the world body could be a powerful catalyst for repeal of Resolution 3379, especially at a time when the climate seems so favorable.

We are also grateful for your reaffirmation of support for repeal at the November 12 meeting with Jewish leaders which I had the privilege of attending.

Since your U.N. speech, we have eagerly looked forward to seeing concrete steps to achieve the objective you have laid out. We are concerned that unless there is a determined and accelerated effort by our representatives, still another session of the U.N. General Assembly will end with Resolution 3379 remaining on the books and continuing to poison the minds and hearts of people around the world about the true nature of Zionism.

Mr. President, you have committed the full weight of your office as well as your personal prestige to repeal of 3379. But repeal will not happen without hands-on action at every stage in the process. U.S. leadership is indispensable.

I am sure you will agree that sixteen years is long enough to wait for a colossal injustice to be undone. We should not have to wait another year. And obviously it would be a blow to America's influence at the world body and in the world if 3379 is not repealed now.

Your strong and sustained support for repeal is greatly appreciated.
