Clinton Honoring 18 Artists, Backers

Eds: Ceremony scheduled to begin 2 p.m. EDT; may stand

WASHINGTON (AP) Casting a broad net, the White House is honoring 18 of the nation's cultural elite, including singer Harry Belafonte, actress Julie Harris, poet Richard Wilbur and folk singer Pete Seeger.

"These extraordinary Americans have borne eloquent testimony to the enduring power of the arts and the human ties in our everyday lives," President Clinton said in a statement prepared for today's ceremony.

First lady Hillary Rodham Clinton called the work of the honorees "an everlasting gift to the nation."

The awards include the National Medal of the Arts and the Charles Frankel Prize in the Humanities.

In addition, Sen. Claiborne Pell, D-R.I., was receiving the Presidential Citizens Medal for "legislative leadership and strong advocacy of the arts and the humanities over the years."

Recipients of the arts medal, with White House descriptions, are:

Harry Belafonte: Began his long career as a singer and actor with "sensual, authentic renderings of Caribbean folk songs."

Dave Brubeck: "Pianist, bandleader, composer and jazz legend."

Celia Cruz: "a contralto with a unique quintessential Afro-Cuban vocal sound and improvisational flair."

Dorothy DeLay: "World renowned teacher of the violin, the first woman and the most influential in her field."

Julie Harris: "One of America's most talented and beloved women of stage and screen."

Erick Hawkins: "The maverick star of America's constellation of dance greats."

Gene Kelly: "An American treasure. A world-class dancer, singer and actor, he is also an award-winning designer, choreographer and producer."

Pete Seeger: "An American folk music legend. ... His own compositions of 'Where Have All the Flowers Gone?' 'If I Had a Hammer,' 'Kisses Sweeter Than Wine,' and 'Turn, Turn, Turn' brought him much deserved personal fame."

Catherine Filene Shouse: Now 98, her philanthropy made possible the National Park Service's Wolf Trap Farm Park for the Performing Arts in Vienna, Va.

Wayne Thiebaud: "Internationally renowned American artist and teacher."

Richard Wilbur: A former U.S. poet laureate, he is "a poet, literary translator, teacher, Broadway lyricist, critic, editor and author of children's books."

Young Audiences, a New York-based group that brings music, dance, theater and the visual arts to more than 6 million young people in 32 states,

Winners of the Frankel Prize are:

Ernest L. Boyer, president of the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching; William Kittredge, an interpreter of the American West and English professor at the University of Montana; Peggy Prenshaw, scholar of Southern literature at Louisiana State University; Sharon Percy Rockefeller, former president of the Washington public broadcasting station, WETA; and Dorothy Porter Wesley, an archivist who was the principal compiler of the black studies collection at Howard University.

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
