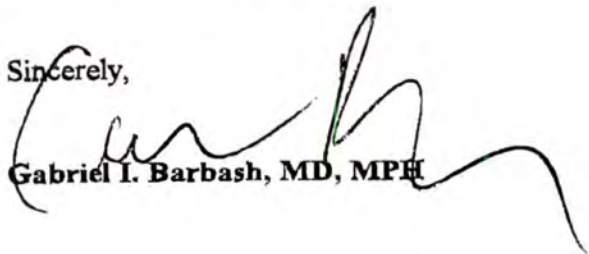
Dear Mrs. Clinton,
