OF STATEHOOD

1. (U) AGAINST THE BACKGROUND OF THE UPCOMING TRIPARTITE SUMMIT IN CAMP DAVID AND THE RECENT DECISION OF THE PLO CENTRAL ASSEMBLY TO DECLARE A PALESTINIAN STATE ON SEPTEMBER 13, THE GOVERNMENT-OWNED NEWSPAPER "OMAN" ON 7/6 CARRIED AN UNSIGNED EDITORIAL (TAKEN TO REFLECT OFFICIAL VIEWS) ADDRESSING ISRAELI REACTIONS TO THE PLO DECISION AND EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE PALESTINIAN STATE. THE EDITORIAL STATED:

-- FOLLOWING THE RECENT ISRAELI STATEMENTS ON THE DECLARATION OF A PALESTINIAN STATE, ONE REALIZES THE IRRESPONSIBILITY OF SUCH COMMENTS (AND THEIR NEGATIVE EFFECT) ON THE POSSIBILITY OF ACHIEVING PEACE IN THE REGION;

-- ARABS IN GENERAL HAVE MADE ALL POSSIBLE CONCESSIONS AND HAVE PROVEN THEIR READINESS TO ACCEPT PEACE AS THE MOST SUITABLE ALTERNATIVE TO END CONFLICT IN THE REGION;

-- DESPITE ALL THE POLITICAL FLEXIBILITY THE ARABS HAVE SHOWN, ISRAEL STILL PROCRASTINATES BY INVENTING INTERNAL CRISES AND JUSTIFICATIONS TO AVOID MEETING ITS PEACE OBLIGATIONS;

-- IN THIS REGARD, THE ISRAELI FOREIGN MINISTER DAVID LEVY ISSUED STATEMENTS THAT A DECLARATION OF A PALESTINIAN STATE IMPLIES A WITHDRAWAL FROM THE MEPP AND THAT ISRAEL DOES NOT ACCEPT PALESTINIAN CLAIMS ON JERUSALEM, BORDERS AND REFUGEES;

-- THE PEACE PROCESS IS AT A STALEMATE AS THE US IS PREOCCUPIED WITH PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS;

-- THE DECLARATION OF A PALESTINIAN STATE IS A LEGITIMATE RIGHT THAT HAS TO BE SUPPORTED;

-- OBLIGATIONS OF THE MEPP HAVE TO BE MET, INCLUDING FINAL STATUS ISSUES SUCH AS JERUSALEM AND THE REFUGEES QUESTION;

-- THE PALESTINIANS SEEM TO BE DISAPPOINTED WITH ISRAELI STUBBORNNESS AND THE ABSENCE OF ENOUGH US PRESSURE ON ISRAEL;

-- THE PALESTINIAN DECISION TO DECLARE STATEHOOD IS WIDELY SUPPORTED BY ARABS AND MUSLIMS, AND ISRAEL HAS TO REALIZE THAT THE REGION MAY ENTER AN ERA OF TENSION AND INSTABILITY IF THE STATUS QUO CONTINUES.

(NOTE: SINCE THE STATE OF PALESTINE WAS DECLARED IN ALGIERS NINE YEARS AGO, OMAN HAS RECOGNIZED THAT STATE AND HOSTS A PALESTINIAN EMBASSY IN MUSCAT. END NOTE.)

2. (SBU) COMMENT: AS NOTED IN REFTTEL, THE OMANIS CONTINUE TO EXPRESS DISAPPOINTMENT WITH THE PACE OF THE PEACE PROCESS, BLAMING ISRAELI INTRANSIGENCE AND US PREOCCUPATION WITH THE UPCOMING PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION. WHILE WELCOMING NEXT WEEK'S SUMMIT, THIS MOST RECENT EDITORIAL CLEARLY FOCUSED ON WHAT IS WRONG WITH THE MEPP, NOT ON WHAT IS RIGHT.

SUBJECT: CAMP DAVID II;CAIRO - JULY 7-9, 2000

1. SUMMARY:

THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT WAS THE MAIN STORY IN ALL MEDIA. IN PARTICULAR, THE EXPECTED MEETING OF PRESIDENT MUBARAK WITH ARAFAT AND BARAK ON THEIR WAY TO WASHINGTON WAS THE LEAD STORY IN ALL PRO-GOVERNMENT PAPERS AND TELEVISION OVER THE WEEKEND. EGYPTIAN FOREIGN MINISTER MOUSSA WAS QUOTED ON JULY 7 SAYING EGYPT IS PAYING GREAT ATTENTION TO THIS SUMMIT.

DESPITE AN OPTIMISTIC HEADLINE IN LEADING PRO-GOVERNMENT AL AHAM, JULY 7, THAT WASHINGTON BELIEVES IN THE POSSIBILITY OF A DEAL DESPITE DOUBTS ABOUT THE SUMMIT RESULTS, OPPOSITION PAPER AL WAFD'S FRONT PAGE OVER THE WEEKEND REITERATED, "ISRAEL IS KILLING PEACE, BARAK REPEATS HIS FAMOUS NOS AND DESTROYS THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT." OPPOSITION AL AHRAR'S FRONT PAGE ON JUNE 8 REPORTED PALESTINIANS AND ISRAELIS PREPARE FOR WAR IN THE WEST BANK AND GAZA IF THE SUMMIT FAILS.

ON JULY 9, PRO-GOVERNMENT PAPERS PROMINENTLY QUOTED EGYPTIAN FOREIGN MINISTER MOUSSA'S STATEMENT THAT BARAK'S NO'S ARE DANGEROUS AND OVERSHADOW THE SUMMIT. ON THE SAME DAY, OPPOSITION AL AHRAR QUOTED THE BOSTON GLOBE THAT, A FEW HOURS BEFORE SUMMIT, ISRAEL AND PALESTINIANS HAD A SECRET DEAL TO RENT PALESTINIAN LAND IN JORDAN VALLEY. IN ADDITION, BOTH PRO-GOVERNMENT AND OPPOSITION EDITORIALS VOICED PESSIMISM OVER THE RESULT OF THIS SUMMIT DUE TO ISRAELI PRIME MINISTER BARAK'S INSISTENCE ON HIS FAMOUS "NO'S."

ON THE DOMESTIC LEVEL, THE ISSUE OF THE DEMOCRATIC ACTIVIST SAAD EDDIN IBRAHIM CONTINUED TO RECEIVE PROMINENT COVERAGE. ALL PAPERS ON JUNE 7 HIGHLIGHTED EGYPTIAN FOREIGN MINISTER MOUSSA'S COMMENT THAT THERE ARE NO AMERICAN PRESSURES ON EGYPT ABOUT SAAD'S CASE. WHILE FACTUAL REPORTS APPEARED ON ALL FRONT PAGES ABOUT THE DEVELOPMENT OF INVESTIGATIONS, BROADLY CIRCULATED PRO-GOVERNMENT AKHBAR AL YOM ON JULY 8 DEVOTED TWO ENTIRE PAGES ABOUT HIS ALLEGED VIOLATIONS. WEEKLY MAGAZINE ROSE AL YOUSSEF ON JULY 9 PUBLISHED DOCUMENTS IT SAID INCRIMINATED SAAD. ONLY NASSERITE OPPOSITION AL ARABI ON JULY 9 PUBLISHED A REPORT THAT THE CASE MAY REVEAL INTENDED GOVERNMENT MALICE AGAINST THE MAN. COPTIC WEEKLY PAPER WATANI'S OPENING EDITORIAL STOOD IN HIS DEFENSE.

THE LEAD STORY IN ALL OPPOSITION PAPERS ON JULY 9, HAILED A CONSTITUTIONAL COURT'S RULING RENDERING SUPERVISION OVER THE PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS AS INVALID SINCE THEY DO NOT INVOLVE LEGAL SUPERVISION.

ON JULY 9, ALL PAPERS REPORTED ON A SERIOUS SETBACK IN THE AMERICAN ANTI-MISSILE PROGRAM AFTER THE THIRD EXPERIMENT FAILED. LEADING PRO-GOVERNMENT AL AHAM UNCLAS SECTION 02 OF 03 CAIRO 004728

-- IBRAHIM NAFIE, EDITOR-IN-CHIEF, PRO-GOVERNMENT DAILY AL AHAM (7/9): "FOR ANY SUMMIT ABOUT MIDDLE EAST PEACE TO SUCCEED, ITS PARTIES SHOULD GO THROUGH CAIRO FIRST. THIS IS A FACT OF THE STRATEGIC SITUATION IN THE REGION. EGYPT'S ROLE IS PIVOTAL.. THE PEACE PROCESS HAS REACHED A DEADLOCK, AND TREMENDOUS EFFORTS ARE NEEDED TO REVIVE IT. THAT IS WHY EGYPT EXPRESSED INTEREST IN THE SUMMIT IN WASHINGTON, IN THE BELIEF THAT THE PALESTINIAN ISSUE IS THE CORE OF THE MIDDLE EAST DISPUTE.. MUBARAK'S EXPECTED MEETING WITH ARAFAT HAS A GREATER SIGNIFICANCE THAN CONSULTATION. EGYPT HAS ALWAYS BEEN THE OFFICIAL AND PUBLIC SUPPORTER OF THE PALESTINIAN CAUSE. OBVIOUSLY, THE AMERICAN ADMINISTRATION IS PAYING GREAT ATTENTION TO THIS SUMMIT, ESPECIALLY AFTER CLINTON ANNOUNCED OPENLY THAT THE SUMMIT IS THE ONLY WAY FOR THE PALESTINIAN AND ISRAELI LEADERSHIPS TO FACE THE REQUIREMENT OF AN AGREEMENT ON MAJOR ISSUES." SUBJECT: THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT;CAIRO - JULY 10, 2000

1. SUMMARY:

THE LEAD STORY IN ALL PRO-GOVERNMENT MEDIA WAS PRESIDENT MUBARAK'S STATEMENT AFTER MEETING WITH ARAFAT BEFORE CAMP DAVID II THAT THE ISSUE OF JERUSALEM CANNOT BE POSTPONED OR IGNORED. THE SAME STORIES QUOTED EGYPTIAN FOREIGN MINISTER MOUSSA AS SAYING THE SUCCESS OF CAMP DAVID IS POSSIBLE IF THERE IS COURAGE AND WILL. ALL FRONT PAGES HIGHLIGHTED THREATS OF COLLAPSE OF BARAK'S GOVERNMENT AS A RESULT OF CAMP DAVID, AS WELL AS THE PALESTINIAN CALL FOR PUBLIC REFERENDUM OVER ANY DEAL WITH ISRAEL. TELEVISION QUOTED SECRETARY ALBRIGHT SAYING THE SUMMIT WILL BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT AND WARNING OF VIOLENCE IF THE SUMMIT FAILS. SENSATIONAL WEEKLY INDEPENDENT AL OSBOAA'S ASKED, "WILL ARAFAT SELL JERUSALEM AND REFUGEES AT CAMP DAVID?" EDITORIAL COMMENTS CONTINUED TO VOICE PESSIMISM OVER THE SUCCESS OF THE SUMMIT.

ALL FRONT PAGES ANNOUNCED THE REFERENDUM ON ANOINTING BASHAR AS PRESIDENT OF SYRIA TODAY.

THE EGYPTIAN CONSTITUTIONAL COURT RULING RENDERING THE PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY INVALID WAS A SIMILARLY PROMINENT TOPIC IN THE PRESS. REPORTEDLY, PRESIDENT MUBARAK WILL REVIEW THE SITUATION TODAY. OPPOSITION AL WAFD HAILED NEWS ABOUT DISSOLVING THE PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY. LIBERAL OPPOSITION AL AHRAR'S BANNER HEADLINE READ, "THE GOVERNMENT IS IN TROUBLE," AND QUOTED THE PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY SPEAKER AS SAYING THAT THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT RULING APPLIES TO THE FORMER ASSEMBLY.

TALKS THAT REQUIRED SECRETARY ALBRIGHT TO VISIT THE REGION TWICE. IN ADDITION, THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE ARE GRAVE.. HOWEVER, THERE IS PESSIMISM DUE TO THE DIFFICULTY OF THE ISSUED TO BE SETTLED IN THE FINAL FRAMEWORK.. THE DIFFICULTY ARISES FROM ISRAEL'S REJECTION TO SETTLE THESE ISSUES ACCORDING TO INTERNATIONAL LEGITIMACY AND DETERMINING REDLINES TO AVOID ABIDING BY INTERNATIONAL RESOLUTIONS.
