Q: WHAT IS YOUR REACTION TO THE CLASHES THIS WEEKEND BETWEEN PRO-DEMOCRACY SUPPORTERS AND HARD-LINE VIGILANTES IN IRAN?

-- WE HAVE SEEN THESE REPORTS.

-- WE AND MANY OTHER NATIONS HAVE WATCHED AS THE IRANIAN PEOPLE HAVE EMBARKED ON A PATH TOWARD GREATER FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY.

-- ONLY THE IRANIAN PEOPLE CAN DETERMINE THE SCOPE AND THE PACE OF THESE CHANGES.

CONTEXT: PEACEFUL PROTESTS, PLANNED BY STUDENT ACTIVISTS TO COMMEMORATE THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE ATTACKS ON STUDENTS BY CONSERVATIVE VIGILANTES/POLICE ON JULY 8 OF LAST YEAR, TURNED VIOLENT ON SATURDAY IN TEHRAN. STUDENT DEMONSTRATORS WERE JOINED BY ORDINARY IRANIANS PROTESTING CONDITIONS INSIDE IRAN AND THE PROTESTS BECAME VIOLENT. THE POLICE APPARENTLY COULD NOT CONTROL THE RIOTING AND VIGILANTES ENTERED THE FRAY TO ATTACK PROTESTERS WITH CLUBS AND ELECTRICAL CABLE. REPORTS INDICATE THAT MANY WERE HURT ON BOTH SIDES. BY SUNDAY CENTRAL TEHRAN WAS CALM. SIMILAR DEMONSTRATIONS IN TWO OTHER CITIES DID NOT TURN VIOLENT. ON SUNDAY AYATOLLAH ALI KHAMENEI BLAMED WESTERN POWERS FOR THE RIOTS, SAYING THAT THEY PLANNED TO DESTROY THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC AS THEY HAD THE SOVIET UNION. ON MONDAY IRANIAN PRESIDENT KHATAMI BEGAN A VISIT TO GERMANY AMIDST PREPARATIONS FOR MAJOR PROTESTS BY IRANIAN GROUPS IN GERMANY.

IRAQ: IRAQI NATIONAL CONGRESS CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING

Q: DO YOU HAVE ANY COMMENT ON THE IRAQI NATIONAL CONGRESS MEETING IN LONDON? WHAT ABOUT REPORTS OF VARIOUS FACTIONAL FIGHTS AND SPLITS?

-- THE IRAQI NATIONAL CONGRESS (INC) CONCLUDED A MEETING OF ITS CENTRAL COUNCIL ON JULY 9. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO CONTINUE THE PROCESS OF ORGANIZING THE INC.

-- I WOULD REFER YOU TO THE IRAQI OPPOSITION FOR ASSESSMENTS OF THEIR VARIOUS MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES DURING THE CENTRAL COUNCIL MEETING.

-- THE U.S. WILL CONTINUE TO SUPPORT THE IRAQI NATIONAL CONGRESS WITH FUNDING, TRAINING, AND MATERIEL COMMENSURATE WITH THE INC'S ABILITY TO USE THAT SUPPORT EFFECTIVELY AND ACCOUNTABLY TO PROMOTE A TRANSITION TO DEMOCRACY IN IRAQ.

Q: WHAT ABOUT REPORTS OF THE IRAQI NATIONAL ACCORD SPLIT FROM THE INC?

-- YOU'LL HAVE TO ASK THE VARIOUS FACTIONS TO DEFINE THEIR ASSOCIATIONS WITH EACH OTHER.

MOST DETAILS OF THE PROCEEDINGS ARE IRRELEVANT TO U.S. POLICY TOWARD THE IRAQI OPPOSITION. HOWEVER, THE IRAQI NATIONAL ACCORD FACTION "FROZE" ITS ASSOCIATION WITH THE INC. THIS IS A FACTIONAL DISPUTE WITHIN THE INC AND SHOULD NOT IMPACT U.S. POLICY TOWARD THE IRAQI OPPOSITION. WE SHOULD NOT, HOWEVER, EXAGGERATE THE POSITIVE ASPECTS OF THE INC MEETING. THE INC AND THE IRAQI OPPOSITION IS STILL IN THE PROCESS OF ORGANIZING ITSELF.

MEPP: SUMMIT UPDATE

Q: CAN YOU GIVE US AN UPDATE ON THE SUMMIT PREPARATIONS?
IS BARAK DELAYING HIS DEPARTURE FOR WASHINGTON BECAUSE OF THE UPCOMING NO-CONFIDENCE VOTE?

-- CHAIRMAN ARAFAT WILL ARRIVE AT ANDREWS AFB LATE THIS EVENING. ISRAELI PM BARAK IS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE AT ANDREWS AFB EARLY TUESDAY MORNING.

-- THE TALKS BETWEEN PRESIDENT CLINTON, PRIME MINISTER BARAK, AND CHAIRMAN ARAFAT WILL BEGIN TUESDAY, JULY 11 AT CAMP DAVID AS ORIGINALLY PLANNED.

-- FOR ANY DETAILS ON THE PARTIES' SPECIFIC TRAVEL PLANS, I WOULD REFER YOU TO THE PARTIES THEMSELVES.

Q: WHAT CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT THE PRE-SUMMIT MEETING HELD YESTERDAY? DID THE SECRETARY PARTICIPATE? WHAT DID IT ACCOMPLISH?

-- THE SECRETARY AND HER TEAM MET WITH THE DELEGATIONS SUNDAY EVENING AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT. U.S. OFFICIALS WILL ALSO BE MEETING WITH THE TWO SIDES TODAY.

-- AS WE'VE SAID MANY TIMES IN THE PAST, WE'RE NOT GOING TO GET INTO SPECIFICS ABOUT THE NATURE OF THESE DISCUSSIONS.

Q: GIVEN THE BARAK'S TENUOUS DOMESTIC SITUATION, IS IT REALISTIC TO BELIEVE THAT HE CAN REACH A DEAL THAT WILL BE SUPPORTED IN ISRAEL? WHAT WILL BE THE IMPACT OF THIS VOTE AND THE BOYCOTT OF THE SUMMIT BY FM LEVY?

-- I'M NOT GOING TO COMMENT ON ISRAELI DOMESTIC POLITICS.

-- AS THE SECRETARY SAID THIS MORNING, THE PRIME MINISTER WAS ELECTED WITH A MANDATE FOR PEACE, AND HE'S COMING TO DO WHAT HE WAS ELECTED TO DO. BARAK HAS SAID THAT WHATEVER AGREEMENT IS REACHED HERE, HE WILL BRING DIRECTLY BACK TO

THE ISRAELI PEOPLE FOR A REFERENDUM.

-- THE PRIME MINISTER'S VIEW IS THAT HE CAN DELIVER A PEACE THAT ISRAELIS WILL SUPPORT, AND THAT ISRAELI VOTERS GAVE HIM A STRONG MANDATE TO WORK TOWARDS THAT GOAL.

-- BOTH PRIME MINISTER BARAK AND CHAIRMAN ARAFAT HAVE SHOWN THAT THEY ARE READY TO TAKE RISKS TO PURSUE PEACE. THE KEY NOW IS TO MOVE THE PROCESS FORWARD, THROUGH THE DIRECT INVOLVEMENT OF THE LEADERS.

Q: BARAK HAS REPORTEDLY GIVEN THE SUMMIT A 50-50% CHANCE, WHILE SOME PALESTINIAN NEGOTIATORS SAY IT WILL PROBABLY FAIL. EVEN MUBARAK HAS SAID THAT BARAK IS NOT ABLE TO MAKE PEACE. IS IT WORTH TAKING THE RISK, GIVEN THOSE VIEWS?

-- THE PRESIDENT MADE CLEAR THAT WE'VE REACHED A POINT WHERE ONLY DECISIONS BY THE LEADERS CAN MOVE THE PROCESS FORWARD. THE PROCESS IS AT A POINT THAT REQUIRES HISTORIC DECISIONS THAT ONLY THE LEADERS CAN MAKE.

-- WHILE THERE IS NO GUARANTEE OF SUCCESS, WE ALSO SEE POTENTIAL FOR PROGRESS. IF WE DIDN'T SEE POTENTIAL, WE WOULDN'T BE MAKING THIS EFFORT.

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-- AS THE PRESIDENT STATED, THERE ARE RISKS OF ACTIONS, BUT ALSO RISKS INVOLVED IN INACTION.

-- ONLY THE ISRAELIS AND PALESTINIANS CAN MAKE THE NECESSARY DECISIONS FOR PEACE. THE UNITED STATES WILL DO WHATEVER WE CAN TO HELP THEM IN THIS PROCESS.

O: WILL YOU PUT PRESSURE ON EITHER SIDE, TO ACHIEVE AN AGREEMENT?

-- THE ISSUE IS NOT ONE OF PRESSURE. THE ISSUE IS HOW TO MAKE THE NEGOTIATIONS A WIN-WIN SITUATION THAT MEETS THE FUNDAMENTAL NEEDS OF BOTH SIDES.

-- THIS IS A PROCESS OF NEGOTIATION AND AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES. ONLY THEY CAN MAKE THE DECISIONS. WE WILL FACILITATE THE PROCESS IN ANYWAY WE CAN.

SYRIA: PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS

Q: COMMENT ON THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS IN SYRIA TODAY? ANY PLANS TO RESUME PEACE TALKS?

-- TODAY, SYRIA IS CONDUCTING A POPULAR REFERENDUM ON BASHAR AL-ASAD'S CANDIDACY FOR PRESIDENT.

-- AS WE'VE SAID BEFORE, WHEN THE SECRETARY MET BASHAR IN DAMASCUS, SHE WAS IMPRESSED WITH HIS COMMITMENT TO THE PEACE PROCESS, AND THAT HE SEEMS POISED AND READY TO ASSUME HIS DUTIES.

[07] Miguel Angel de la Guardia reads the "Radio Havana Comments" editorial: Even though the United States has been Israel's major protector and its main supporter regarding its expansionist policies in the Middle East at the expense of Arab peoples, the large power now acts as promoter of peace among the usurpers and the dispossessed people. Anyone would think that Israeli authorities are obligated to accept the resolve of their powerful protectors, leaving Palestinians the West Bank territory, which Zionists have occupied for so many years, so that they would be able to establish their own state there.

The occupying forces could also be expected to withdraw from the Golan Heights in Syrian territory, which was also occupied during the last war in the Middle East. However, they stubbornly refuse to do so by putting conditions that harm Syria's sovereign rights. Israeli rulers have been standing up to Washington, as the anti-Cuban counterrevolutionary mafiosi living in Florida just did. The United States now has had to sit down at the same table of negotiations between Israel and Palestine to try to achieve the peace needed now at the very large oil region.

Israelis have pulled out their occupation troops from some of the occupied territories and have had to tolerate the presence of the PLO, which is presided over by Yasir 'Arafat, in the West Bank area they have had to leave behind. However, both in the West Bank and southern Lebanon, from where they have had to withdraw, the Israeli troops remain very close to the border with the Gaza Strip in a menacing attitude, and they could at any time repeat the Middle East tragedy by returning to the starting point.

The Palestinians' decision to proclaim their independent state when the period agreed on for the two parties to find a peaceful solution to the conflict end would be considered by Israel, according to what Foreign Minister David Levy has said, as Palestine's withdrawal from the peace process and, consequently, a resumption of the state of war.

President Clinton has said that he would sit down in Camp David with the representatives of Israel and the Palestine National Authority to try to convince them to end the talks on a happy note. However, the US president himself does not seem to be confident that he will obtain good results. This shows that the policies of Washington, which has never hesitated to use any type of pressure, including armed actions, is too soft with its traditional accomplices and seems to be incapable of making them listen to reason even though it is a matter of political and strategic interests of the large power.

All the strength and influence of these accomplices depends on the policies of Washington, which has supported them and promoted their usurpation and dispossession policies. Biting the hand that has always supported them could bring serious difficulties to the usurpers, unless it is another show to deceive or confuse the world community.
