MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS

-- 'ILLEGAL INTRANSIGENCE', AN EDITORIAL BY EDITOR-IN-CHIEF MUSTAPHA KHAMMARI IN INDEPENDENT, FRENCH-LANGUAGE DAILY "LE TEMPS" (7/18):

'WE STILL DO NOT KNOW WHETHER AMERICAN, PALESTINIAN, AND ISRAELI PESSIMISM IS A SIGN THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS AT CAMP DAVID WILL END IN A DEADLOCK. THE APPARENT PESSIMISM COULD BE A SIMPLE PLOY TO REDUCE PRESSURE ON THE PARTIES... CLINTON HAS STATED THAT THESE ARE THE TOUGHEST NEGOTIATIONS THAT HE HAS TAKEN PART IN. DESPITE THE DIFFICULTIES OF THE NEGOTIATIONS, THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY EXPECTS THE UNITED STATES TO PUT AN END TO ISRAELI INTRANSIGENCE. ISRAELI AND PALESTINIAN DEMANDS CANNOT BE CONSIDERED IN THE SAME TERMS... THE UNITED STATES' REFUSAL TO TRANSFER ITS

EMBASSY FROM TEL AVIV TO JERUSALEM INDICATES THAT IT MAY HAVE COME TO UNDERSTAND THIS FACT. WHILE THE LEGITIMATE CLAIM OF THE PALESTINIANS TO THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES IS WIDELY ENDORSED BY THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY AND SUPPORTED BY UN RESOLUTIONS, ISRAELI INTRANSIGENCE IS INCREASINGLY BEING SEEN AS AN OBSTACLE TO JUSTICE. IT IS CLEAR THAT THE ONLY ROAD TO PEACE IS TO RETURN THE LAND TO THE PALESTINIANS. IF THE SUMMIT ACHIEVES THIS GOAL, IT WILL HAVE RIGHTED A HISTORIC WRONG... ONLY WASHINGTON CAN TELL ISRAEL THAT ROGUE COUNTRIES ARE OUTLAWS AND SHOULD BE SANCTIONED.' RAPHEL

1. SUMMARY: AT THE REGULAR JULY 20 BRIEFING, MFA
SPOKESPERSON ZHU BANGZAO REPORTED THAT CHINA REGRETTED
THE FAILURE OF THE TRILATERAL DISCUSSIONS AT CAMP DAVID.
ZHU CONDEMNED THE FALUN GONG ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF
THE GOVERNMENT'S DECISION TO OUTLAW THE GROUP. ZHU SAID
CHINA WAS SATISFIED WITH PUTIN'S VISIT AND THEIR COMMON
STANCE ON NMD. HE WOULD NOT CONFIRM REPORTS OF A DPRK
OFFER TO GIVE UP ITS MISSILE PROGRAM IN EXCHANGE FOR
ASSISTANCE WITH SPACE EXPLORATION. THIS WAS THE LAST
MFA PRESS BRIEFING UNTIL SEPTEMBER 5. END SUMMARY.

US-ISRAEL-PALESTINIAN SUMMIT

2. MFA PRESS SPOKESMAN ZHU BANGZAO SAID CHINA REGRETTED THE FAILURE ONCE AGAIN OF THE TRILATERAL DISCUSSIONS AT CAMP DAVID. ZHU NOTED THAT CHINA WOULD CONTINUE TO BE SUPPORTIVE OF THE PEACE PROCESS AS A PERMANENT MEMBER OF THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL. CHINA BELIEVED THAT ISRAEL AND PALESTINE COULD ONLY ACHIEVE PEACE BY FOLLOWING THE ORIGINAL UN RESOLUTIONS. HE COMMENTED THAT BOTH SIDES HAD DEMONSTRATED A LACK OF RESOLVE DURING THE SUMMIT AND NEEDED TO WORK HARDER. ZHU ADDED THAT IN THIS SITUATION THE UN SHOULD NOT BE EXPECTED TO RESPOND AS IT HAD IN KOSOVO.

ANNIVERSARY OF FALUNGONG BAN

3. LAST YEAR THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT TOOK A FIRM STANCE AGAINST THE LAW-BREAKING FALUNGONG, ZHU SAID. SINCE THEN, CHINA HAD "WON A MAJOR VICTORY OVER THE ORGANIZATION." ZHU CITED THE "EVIL CULT'S ILLEGAL ACTIONS AGAINST SCIENCE, AGAINST CULTURE, AND AGAINST HUMANITY," AND ALSO NOTED THE GOVERNMENT'S DESIRE TO "EDUCATE THE GREAT NUMBERS OF FALUNGONG MEMBERS THAT HAVE BEEN DECEIVED AND HELP THEM ESCAPE FROM THE PSYCHOLOGICAL CONTROL OF THE SECT." IN RESPONDING TO THE THREAT FROM FALUNGONG, ZHU SAID, THE GOVERNMENT WOULD CONTINUE TO "EDUCATE THE MAJORITY ABOUT ITS DANGERS AND CRACK DOWN ON HARDCORE ELEMENTS." RESPONDING TO A FOREIGN REPORTER'S QUESTION, ZHU WOULD NOT CONFIRM WHETHER 90 SECT MEMBERS HAD BEEN ARRESTED THAT MORNING.

PUTIN VISIT/NMD

4. ZHU RECAPPED THE JULY 16-19 VISIT OF RUSSIAN FEDERATION PRESIDENT VLADIMIR PUTIN, HOSTED BY JIANG ZEMIN. PUTIN AND HIGH LEVEL CHINESE OFFICIALS DISCUSSED STRENGTHENING BILATERAL COOPERATION IN POLITICS, SCIENCE, LITERATURE, AND EDUCATION. PUTIN AND JIANG DISCUSSED NATIONAL MISSILE DEFENSE AND SIGNED THE "BEIJING DECLARATION." ZHU STATED BOTH SIDES "WOULD CONTINUE TO SUPPORT STRATEGIC BALANCE AND STABILITY." BOTH SIDES SUPPORTED MAINTAINING A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP AND WOULD CLOSELY WATCH AND CRITIQUE FUTURE NMD DEVELOPMENTS, HE SAID.

DPRK

5. ASKED ABOUT REPORTS THAT NORTH KOREA HAD OFFERED TO GIVE UP ITS MISSILE PROGRAM IN EXCHANGE FOR ASSISTANCE WITH SPACE EXPLORATION ROCKETS, ZHU COMMENTED THAT, "WE HAVE SEEN THESE REPORTS, BUT ARE UNFAMILIAR WITH THE ISSUE."
