2. [00] Fidel Castro on the evening of 22 July attended the commencement of Havana's art schools and handed the diplomas to the nine best students. Video shows Castro handing diplomas to students, valedictorian speaking, ballet dancers on stage, ballet teacher speaking, music students performing, public in attendance, students making statements. (Politburo report)

3. [03] On 23 July, 13 buildings and 106 homes opened in Havana and Pinar del Rio to mark another 26 July anniversary. Video shows row of new homes, new homeowners making statements, Blas Roca Contingent workers on line, local official making statements.

4. [04] Hundreds of Spaniards on 23 July marched down streets in Madrid, Spain, to demand an end to the US blockade on Cuba. Video shows Madrid street scenes, people marching.
