PRESIDENCY ON BEHALF OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

1. THE PRESIDENCY OF THE EUROPEAN UNION RELEASED THE
FOLLOWING STATEMENT IN FRENCH ON JULY 25, 2000 IN PARIS ON
BEHALF OF THE EUROPEAN UNION. FOLLOWING IS AN INFORMAL
EMBASSY TRANSLATION.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

-- THE EUROPEAN UNION SALUTES THE PERSONAL COMMITMENT,
DETERMINATION AND TIRELESS EFFORTS OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE
UNITED STATES AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR HAVING
ATTEMPTED TO CLEAR A WAY TOWARD PEACE AT THE CAMP DAVID
SUMMIT. THE EUROPEAN UNION ALSO SALUTES THE COURAGE OF THE
PRIME MINISTER OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL, MR. BARAK, AND THE
PRESIDENT OF THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY, MR. ARAFAT, DURING
NEGOTIATIONS AIMED AT REACHING A HISTORICAL RECONCILIATION
BETWEEN THE ISRAELI AND PALESTINIAN PEOPLES.

-- WEEKS OF NEGOTIATION DEMONSTRATED THAT ALL ISSUES,
INCLUDING THE MOST DIFFICULT, WERE EXPLORED TO THE EXTENT
POSSIBLE. FOR THE FIRST TIME, SUBJECTS THAT WERE
PREVIOUSLY OFF LIMITS WERE BROACHED. THE RESPONSIBLE
ATTITUDES OF THE PARTIES ALLOWED POSITIONS, WHICH UNTIL
RECENTLY SEEMED IRRECONCILABLE, TO EVOLVE. REMAINING
OBSTACLES, WHICH PREVENTED A SETTLEMENT FROM BEING
ACHIEVED, MUST NOW BE OVERCOME.

-- THE HOPE BORN FROM THESE WEEKS OF NEGOCIATION CANNOT BE
ALLOWED TO DIE. MORE THAN EVER, THERE IS NO SOLUTION BUT
PEACE.

SUBJECT: STATEMENT BY JORDANIAN MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
AL-KHATIB ON OUTCOME OF CAMP DAVID SUMMIT.

1. ON JULY 26, THE JORDANIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF
THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT. AN INFORMAL EMBASSY TRANSLATION
FOLLOWS.

BEGIN TEXT: MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS ABDUL ILAH AL-
KHATIB SAID THAT THE REGION IS PASSING THROUGH A VERY
CRITICAL AND SERIOUS PHASE. THE PEOPLE OF THE REGION WERE
LOOKING FORWARD TO THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT, HOPING TO ACHIEVE
FUNDAMENTAL PROGRESS IN THE PALESTINIAN ISRAELI
NEGOTIATIONS AND BELIEVING THAT PEACE AND STABILITY CAN
SPREAD IN THE REGION ONLY WHEN THE CENTRAL ISSUE, THE
PALESTINIAN CAUSE, IS SOLVED IN A WAY THAT GIVES THE
PALESTINIAN PEOPLE BACK THEIR RIGHTS AND AMBITIONS,
ESPECIALLY THEIR RIGHT TO ESTABLISH THEIR INDEPENDENT
PALESTINIAN STATE ON THEIR NATIONAL LAND AND WITH JERUSALEM
AS ITS CAPITAL.

HE ADDED IN A STATEMENT TO THE JORDANIAN PRESS AGENCY THAT
JORDAN HAS BEEN FOLLOWING UP ON THE CAMP DAVID NEGOTIATIONS
THROUGH COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE THREE PARTIES. "WE
REALIZED FROM THE START HOW HARD AND SENSITIVE ALL OF THE
NEGOTIATIONS' ISSUES ARE AND ALSO HOW SERIOUS THE NEEDED
DECISIONS ARE".

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE U.S. PRESIDENT INVESTED UNIQUE AND
UNPRECEDENTED EFFORT TO HELP BOTH PARTIES TAKE THOSE
DECISIONS.

MR. KHATIB SAID THAT "ALTHOUGH WE REALIZE THAT THE PARTIES

COULD NOT REACH AGREEMENT ON ALL THE DISCUSSED ISSUES, IT IS CLEAR THAT THE PARTIES DEVELOPED A CERTAIN LEVEL OF UNDERSTANDING AND NARROWED THE GAP SEPARATING THEM ON MANY ISSUES".

HE ALSO SAID, "IT IS CLEAR THAT JERUSALEM WAS THE MOST COMPLICATED AND MOST SENSITIVE ISSUE. IT WAS ALSO PROVEN THAT SUCCESS IN REACHING A FINAL AND PERMANENT SETTLEMENT DEPENDS ON SOLVING THESE ISSUES WHILE TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THE CRITICAL STATUS OF JERUSALEM, WHICH IS PERCEIVED BY THE ARAB AND ISLAMIC COMMUNITIES THROUGH RELIGIOUS AND HISTORICAL EYES, WHICH ADD TO ITS SPIRITUAL AND POLITICAL IMPORTANCE TO THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE".

THE MINISTER STRESSED THAT JORDAN HAS ALWAYS DEALT WITH THE JERUSALEM ISSUE WITH THE SERIOUSNESS AND CARE IT DESERVED, SINCE ACCORDING TO SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 242, JORDAN STILL HOLDS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF TAKING CARE OF THE HOLY SITES UNTIL A JUST AGREEMENT IS REACHED.

MR. KHATIB EXPRESSED HIS TRUST THAT THE U.S. PRESIDENT WILL CONTINUE HIS GOOD EFFORTS AND ATTEMPTS TO REACH AN AGREEMENT, AND POINTED OUT THE ISRAELI AND PALESTINIAN COMMITMENT TO AVOID DOING ANYTHING THAT COULD INCREASE THE DIFFICULTIES OF REACHING A SETTLEMENT, AND TO CONTINUE THE NEGOTIATIONS DURING THE NEXT FEW WEEKS IN ORDER TO REACH AN AGREEMENT BEFORE THE 13TH OF SEPTEMBER.

1. ON JULY 26, THE ALGERIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF

THE CAMP DAVID SUMMIT. AN INFORMAL EMBASSY TRANSLATION
FOLLOWS.

2. BEGIN TEXT: ALGERIA, WHICH FOLLOWED WITH ATTENTION AND
INTEREST THE NEGOTIATIONS AT CAMP DAVID BETWEEN THE
PALESTINIAN AND ISRAELI DELEGATIONS, UNDER THE SPONSORSHIP
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF THE
PALESTINIAN QUESTION, TAKES NOTE, WITH REGRET, OF THE
FAILURE OF THESE NEGOTIATIONS, AS ANNOUNCED BY PRESIDENT
CLINTON.

3. ALGERIA, WHICH HAS CONSTANTLY SUPPORTED EFFORTS AIMING
AT A COMPREHENSIVE, JUST, AND LASTING SOLUTION TO THE MIDDLE
EAST CONFLICT, AND MAINLY THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION WHICH IS
AT THE HEART OF THIS CONFLICT, REAFFIRMS ITS SUPPORT FOR THE
CONTINUATION OF THESE EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE A DEFINITIVE PEACE
AND TO ASSURE STABILITY AND SECURITY THROUGHOUT THE REGION.

4. ALGERIA REMAINS CONVINCED THAT THE ACHIEVEMENT OF A
COMPREHENSIVE, JUST, AND LASTING PEACE IN THE REGION WILL
DEPEND ON THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE ACHIEVING THEIR RIGHTS,
ESPECIALLY THE RIGHT TO A NATIONAL INDEPENDENT STATE WITH
JERUSALEM, OCCUPIED SINCE 1967, AS ITS CAPITAL AND THE RIGHT
OF RETURN OF REFUGEES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTIONS 194,
242, AND 338 OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL AND THE PRINCIPLE OF
LAND FOR PEACE, RECOGNIZED BY THE MADRID PEACE CONFERENCE.

5. IN THIS CRUCIAL PHASE OF THE PEACE PROCESS, ALGERIA CALLS ON THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY TO MOBILIZE ITS EFFORTS TO CONVINCE ISRAEL TO ABIDE BY INTERNATIONAL LEGALITY, TO RESPECT ITS OBLIGATIONS IN THE FRAMEWORK OF AGREEMENTS REACHED WITH THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY, AND TO RESTART QUICKLY NEGOTIATIONS WITH SYRIA TO ASSURE ITS COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM THE GOLAN HEIGHTS.

6. ON THIS OCCASION ALGERIA PRAISES PRESIDENT CLINTON AND SECRETARY OF STATE ALBRIGHT FOR THEIR EFFORTS TO MOVE FORWARD THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS. END TEXT. HUME

1. THE SWEDISH MFA HAS ISSUED A PRESS RELEASE IN WHICH FOREIGN MINISTER ANNA LINDH PRAISED THE CAMP DAVID NEGOTIATIONS. LINDH STATED THAT SWEDEN, AS A MEMBER OF THE EU TROIKA, IS WILLING TO TAKE AN ACTIVE PART IN IDENTIFYING WHAT THE EU CAN DO TO SUPPORT THE PEACE PROCESS, BUT STRESSED THAT IT IS THE U.S. WHICH MUST CONTINUE TO PLAY THE MAIN ROLE IN THE EFFORTS FOR PEACE.

"IT IS IMPORTANT TO REGARD THE CAMP DAVID NEGOTIATIONS NOT AS THE END OF THE PEACE PROCESS BUT AS A STEP ON THE WAY TO AN AGREEMENT. THE ISRAELIS AND PALESTINIANS HAVE BEEN DISCUSSING ISSUES IN A DIFFERENT VEIN FROM PREVIOUSLY AND SEVERAL VITAL NEW ELEMENTS HAVE COME INTO THE PROCESS. THAT REFUGEE QUESTIONS AND THE KEY ISSUE OF JERUSALEM HAVE COME UP IN DIRECT TALKS BETWEEN THE PRIME MINISTER EHUD BARAK AND PRESIDENT YASSIR ARAFAT ARE A SIGN OF THIS", SAID THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, ANNA LINDH ON WEDNESDAY MORNING.

"THE FACT THAT BOTH PARTIES HAVE ALSO PROMISED NOT TO TAKE ACTION THAT WOULD ENDANGER THE CHANCE OF NEW INITIATIVES IN THE NEGOTIATIONS IS ALSO A STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION. WE HOPE THAT THE NEW NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE RESUMED WITHIN A COUPLE OF WEEKS," SHE

CONTINUED.

ANNA LINDH ALSO EXPRESSED THE SWEDISH GOVERNMENT'S APPRECIATION OF WHAT PRESIDENT BILL CLINTON AND FOREIGN MINISTER MADELEINE ALBRIGHT HAD DONE ON ORDER TO BRING THE PARTIES TOGETHER AND TO PERSUADE THEM TO TRY SOLUTIONS THAT HAD BEEN TABOO FOR THEIR OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVES IN THE PAST.

"THE SITUATION THAT HAS NOW EMERGED RAISES HOPES THAT THE EU WILL JOIN IN EFFORTS TOWARDS RESUMPTION OF THE NEGOTIATIONS. TOGETHER WITH FRANCE, THE PRESIDENT COUNTRY OF THE EU, AND THE EU SPECIAL ENVOY FOR THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS, SWEDEN AS A MEMBER OF THE EU TROIKA IS WILLING TO TAKE AN ACTIVE PART IN IDENTIFYING WHAT THE EU CAN DO TO SUPPORT THE PEACE PROCESS. BUT IT IS THE UNITED STATES WHICH MUST CONTINUE TO PLAY THE MAIN ROLE AS THE OUTSIDE PARTY IN THE EFFORTS FOR PEACE," SAID THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

"IT IS ALSO VITAL THAT THE EU SUPPORTS THE MEASURES TAKEN BY BOTH SIDES AIMED AT PREPARING THEIR RESPECTIVE PUBLIC OPINIONS FOR THE FACT THAT COMPROMISE WILL BE NEEDED AND NEW THINKING NECESSARY IN ORDER TO REACH A FINAL PEACE AGREEMENT," EMPHASIZED MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, ANNA LINDH.
