1. THE FOLLOWING IS EMBASSY AMMAN'S SUBMISSION FOR
THE 1994 INTERNATIONAL NARCOTICS CONTROL STRATEGY
REPORT.

PART I: SUMMARY

2. JORDAN HAS COMPARATIVELY FEW PROBLEMS WITH DRUG
USE/ABUSE. CULTURAL NORMS LIMIT THE USE OF DRUGS
PRIMARILY TO HASHISH. ILLEGAL TRANSPORTATION FROM
SURROUNDING COUNTRIES IS STILL A CONCERN TO LOCAL
AUTHORITIES. COOPERATION WITH JORDAN'S NEIGHBORS
REGARDING ILLEGAL TRANSPORTATION IS GOOD AND
CONTINUES TO IMPROVE. PROGRAMS FOR REHABILITATION
AND EDUCATION CONTINUE TO GROW. A HOSPITAL FOR THE

TREATMENT OF DRUG-RELATED PROBLEMS OPENED EARLIER THIS YEAR, AND SHOWS THE COMMITMENT TO KEEPING DRUG-RELATED PROBLEMS MANAGEABLE. END SUMMARY

PART II: STATUS OF COUNTRY

3. EMBASSY AMMAN DOES NOT EXPECT JORDAN'S MINIMAL INVOLVEMENT IN THE PRODUCTION, MONEY LAUNDERING OR PRECURSOR CHEMICALS MANUFACTURING TO CHANGE SIGNIFICANTLY. DRUG TRAFFICKING CONTINUES TO BE OF CONCERN, HOWEVER, AND IS ACTIVELY PURSUED THROUGH LAW ENFORCEMENT MEANS, I.E. BORDER CONTROL, ENFORCING OVERLAND TRANSPORTATION REGULATIONS, SURVEILLANCE OF SUSPECTS AND INCREASED PRISON SENTENCES FOR CONVICTIONS.

PART III: COUNTRY ACTIONS AGAINST DRUGS IN 1994

4. JORDAN IS A PARTY TO THE 1988 U.N. CONVENTION. JORDANIAN AUTHORITIES MAINTAIN CURRENT LIAISON WITH FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS ON INTERNATIONAL NARCOTICS MATTERS. JORDANIAN POLICE AND SECURITY SERVICES HAVE EXCELLENT PROFESSIONAL RELATIONSHIPS WITH INTERPOL AND APPROPRIATE U.S. LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES. THERE HAS NOT BEEN A MARKED IMPROVEMENT IN THE NATIONAL DRUG POLICY IN 1994 DUE PRIMARILY TO BUDGET AND PERSONNEL CONSTRAINTS. MOREOVER, THE RECENT DEVELOPMENTS CONCERNING THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS HAVE OVERSHADOWED ACTUAL ENFORCEMENT AND POLICY IMPLEMENTATIONS.

5. THERE IS A CURRENT INCREASE IN THE ABUSE OF OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS. THIS HAS RESULTED IN THE INCREASE OF REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE DRUGS. APPROXIMATELY TWO YEARS AGO, THE PUBLIC SECURITY DIRECTORATE (PSD) ESTABLISHED A PROGRAM OF DRUG AWARENESS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS. WHEN COUPLED WITH CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS NORMS, THIS IS SEEN BY THE GOJ TO BE AN EFFECTIVE TOOL IN AVOIDING FUTURE DRUG PROBLEMS. ILLICIT CULTIVATION, PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION, FINANCING AND MONEY LAUNDERING ARE NOT CONSIDERED MAJOR PROBLEMS. ALTHOUGH THESE PROBLEMS EXIST, THEY ARE EXCEPTIONALLY RARE. THE U.S. AND JORDAN ARE CURRENTLY ENGAGED IN NEGOTIATING AN EXTRADITION TREATY, AND A DRAFT WAS PROVISIONALLY AGREED TO BY THE TWO SIDES IN DECEMBER 1994. IT HAS NOT YET ENTERED INTO FORCE. ARTICLE 12 OF THE PEACE TREATY BETWEEN JORDAN AND ISRAEL, CALLS FOR COOPERATION TO COMBAT AND PREVENT CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING TRAFFICKING IN ILLICIT DRUGS. THE TWO SIDES FORMED A JOINT COMMITTEE TO NEGOTIATE ON THE MEANS TO IMPLEMENT THIS PROVISION.

6. LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS FOR COUNTER-NARCOTICS HAVE GROWN MODERATELY DUE TO THE CHANGING POLITICAL SITUATION IN THE MID-EAST. DRUG SEIZURES DUE TO ILLEGAL INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION HAVE INCREASED MODERATELY. NARCOTICS TRAFFICKING FROM LEBANON AND SYRIA, THROUGH JORDAN, TO EGYPT AND THE GULF STATES UNCLAS SECTION 02 OF 03 AMMAN 015215

IS OF CONTINUAL CONCERN. JORDAN, SYRIA, LEBANON AND EGYPT COOPERATE OUT OF SHARED CONCERN IN STEMMING ILLEGAL TRAFFICKING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTRIES. IN OCTOBER, A SEIZURE OF 760 KILOGRAMS OF HASHISH AT THE JOINT BORDER BETWEEN SYRIA AND JORDAN LED TO THE ARREST OF EIGHT INDIVIDUALS. THIS WAS A CONTROLLED DELIVERY AND INVOLVED ACTIVE SURVEILLANCE IN BOTH COUNTRIES. THE SHIPMENT WAS BOUND FOR SAUDI ARABIA. INFORMATION EXCHANGE AND BETTER MUTUAL COOPERATION SHOULD CONTINUE TO LEAD TO MORE ARRESTS AND CONVICTIONS. THE EASING OF PREVIOUS BORDER AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS IS SEEN AS LEADING TO THE POSSIBLE INCREASE OF INTERNATIONAL DRUG TRAFFICKING. THIS PROBLEM HAS YET TO PRODUCE CHANGES IN POLICY.

7. INM PROVIDED NARCOTICS TEST KITS TO THE PSD EARLIER THIS YEAR USING FY 93 FUNDS. ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT SUCH AS HANDCUFFS AND FLASHLIGHTS FOR PSD OFFICERS IS STILL PENDING. JORDANIAN ARMED FORCES (JAF) HAVE EXPRESSED AN INTEREST IN BECOMING INVOLVED IN DRUG ENFORCEMENT AND IN BETTER COORDINATION WITH THE GOJ OFFICE OF ANTI-NARCOTICS AND COUNTERFEITING. HOST MILITARY FORCES ARE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT SURVEILLANCE AND DETAIN PRIVATE CITIZENS WHO ARE THEN TURNED OVER TO CIVILIAN POLICE AGENCIES. COORDINATION BETWEEN THE MILITARY AND ANTI-NARCOTICS OFFICE IS ADEQUATE.

PART IV: USG POLICY INITIATIVES AND PROGRAMS

8. THERE HAVE BEEN NO CHANGES IN DRUG LAWS IN JORDAN DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS. THE JORDANIAN GOVERNMENT BASES ITS DRUG LAWS ON THE 1988 U.N. CONVENTION, AS WELL AS ON CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS NORMS. DRUG USAGE IS NOT PERCEIVED AS A MAJOR PROBLEM. DRUG ADDICTS AND ABUSERS ARE USUALLY PLACED IN REHABILITATION PROGRAMS AND ARE OFTEN NOT IMPRISONED. THE JORDANIAN STATE SECURITY COURT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DEALING WITH DRUG-RELATED ACTIVITY. DISTRIBUTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF DRUGS CARRY HEAVY PENALTIES. ASSET SEIZURE HAS BEEN USED SINCE 1988

AND IS MODELED AFTER U.S. POLICY AND PROGRAMS. SEIZED ASSETS BECOME PROPERTY OF THE GOVERNMENT. IT IS NOT CLEAR WHAT HAPPENS TO THE ASSETS AFTER SEIZURE. MANPOWER, BUDGET CONSTRAINTS AND EQUIPMENT SHORTAGES ARE COMMON AND INDICATE A LACK OF PRIORITIZING LAW ENFORCEMENT.

9. CORRUPTION OF SENIOR GOJ OFFICIALS IS NOT COMMONPLACE. DRUG-RELATED CORRUPTION OF LOWER ECHELON OFFICIALS OR POLICE AND BORDER ENFORCEMENT IS MORE FREQUENT. GOJ ANTI-NARCOTICS OFFICIALS HAVE STATED THAT WHEN CORRUPTION ALLEGATIONS SURFACE, THE INDIVIDUAL(S) ARE DEALT WITH THROUGH THE CRIMINAL COURT SYSTEM JUST AS ANY OTHER "CRIMINAL" WOULD BE. ISSUES REGARDING CORRUPTION ARE RARELY MADE PUBLIC. JORDAN HAS CRIMINAL LAWS TO DEAL WITH CORRUPTION OF GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. HOWEVER, CORRUPTION OF OFFICIALS IS NOT SEEN AS A MAJOR PROBLEM BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THERE IS NO GOVERNMENT POLICY OR PRACTICE OF ENCOURAGING OR FACILITATING ILLICIT PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION OR TRANSPORTATION OF ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES. CROP CULTIVATION OR PRODUCTION OF DRUGS IN JORDAN IS MINIMAL AND ACCORDING TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES DOES NOT EXIST.

MONEY LAUNDERING

10. GENERAL: GOJ OFFICIALS DO NOT BELIEVE MONEY LAUNDERING EXISTS IN JORDAN. THERE ARE NO LAWS FOR FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS TO COMPLY WITH, AND NO PROGRAMS IN PLACE TO DEAL WITH MONEY LAUNDERING IF IT WERE TO BECOME A MAJOR PROBLEM. EMBASSY ECONOMICS SECTION VERIFIED THIS INFORMATION. LOCAL AUTHORITIES KNOW THAT MOST TRANSPORTATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF DRUGS IS ON A CASH BASIS AND HANDLED BY BEDOUIN TRIBESMEN. THIS DOES NOT ALLOW FOR THE EASY TRACKING OF DRUG MONEY OR CONTROL OF THE UNCLAS SECTION 03 OF 03 AMMAN 015215

11. THE PRODUCTION OF ESSENTIAL CHEMICAL SOURCES

DOES NOT EXIST IN JORDAN. THERE HAVE
BEEN NO
ARRESTS OR SEIZURES OF CHEMICALS OR MANUFACTURING
FACILITIES IN THE LAST TWO YEARS.
