(A) SUMMARY OF TYPE OF COVERAGE:
THE "SCHOOL WAR" MAKES FRONT-PAGE HEADLINES THIS
MORNING, AS THE CONSTITUTIONAL COUNCIL STRUCK DOWN AS
UNCONSTITUTIONAL A CONTROVERSIAL BILL TO PROVIDE
UNRESTRICTED PUBLIC FUNDS TO FRANCE'S MOSTLY CATHOLIC
PRIVATE SCHOOLS. OPPONENTS OF THE BILL, INCLUDING

TEACHERS' UNIONS AND LEFTIST OPPOSITION PARTIES, SAY THIS IS THE BIGGEST DEFEAT FOR POPULAR CONSERVATIVE PRIME MINISTER BALLADUR SINCE HE TOOK OFFICE IN MARCH. PRESIDENT CLINTON'S TRIP TO MOSCOW IS THE LEAD FOREIGN STORY. ALL MEDIA FACTUALLY REPORT ON HIS MEETING WITH RUSSIAN PRESIDENT YELTSIN YESTERDAY.

COMMENTATORS MENTION THAT YELTSIN SUPPORTS THE PARTNERSHIP FOR PEACE, AND NOTE THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TWO SIDES TO RE-TARGET THEIR NUCLEAR WEAPONS AWAY FROM EACH OTHERS

ALL MENTION CLINTON'S REAFFIRMED SUPPORT FOR REFORMS IN RUSSIA, BUT ADD THAT THE U.S. PRESIDENT IS OFFERING NO NEW FINANCIAL AID.

FOCUS IS ON THE SIGNING OF A DENUCLEARIZATION ACCORD WITH UKRAINIAN PRESIDENT KRAVCHUK. MANY COMMENTATORS, LIKE MARIE-FRANCE CALLE IN LES ECHOS, VIEW THIS AS "THE KEY EVENT" IN BILL CLINTON'S RUSSIAN VISIT.

AGENCE FRANCE PRESSE REPORTS THAT MIDDLE EAST EXPERTS THINK THAT THE CLINTON-ASSAD SUMMIT SUNDAY IN GENEVA "COULD UNBLOCK THE NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN ISRAEL AND SYRIA AND, IN THE LONG RUN, OPEN THE WAY TOWARDS PEACE BETWEEN THESE TWO COUNTRIES." AFP QUOTES AN ISRAELI OFFICIAL AS SAYING: "WE ARE ON THE VERGE OF REACHING A BREAKTHROUGH AND THE GENEVA SUMMIT WILL EASE THIS BREAKTHROUGH." AFP ALSO REPORTS THAT THE SPOKESMAN OF THE FRENCH MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, RICHARD DUQUE, SAID YESTERDAY THAT THE CLINTON-ASSAD MEETING WAS "A GOOD THING".

THE BEIJING BUREAU OF AGENCE FRANCE PRESSE REPORTS THAT THE CHINESE FOREIGN MINISTRY SAID THAT U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE WARREN CHRISTOPHER WILL MEET WITH CHINESE FOREIGN MINISTER QIAN QICHEN ON JANUARY 24 IN PARIS.

CONSERVATIVE LE FIGARO PUBLISHED ARTICLES ON ORGAN TRANSPLANTS, AND ORGAN TRAFFICKING. YESTERDAY'S PIECE, BY MICHELE BIETRY, SUBTITLES: "BASED ON SOME WEAK REPORTS, THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASING NUMBER OF GHOST OF ABOMINATION ABOUT CLANDESTINE ORGAN TRAFFICKING. WITH NO CONVINCING EVIDENCE." IN THE REPORT, BIETRY SAYS: "ONE IS NOT ENTITLED TO EXTRAPOLATE, OR ONE, WILL PROPAGATE RUMORS. HOWEVER, THERE ARE REASONS WHICH MAKE FOR TRAFFICKING. THIS IS WHY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE AND HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENSE ORGANIZATIONS ARE CARRYING OUT IN-DEPTH INVESTIGATIONS, BOTH TO KILL FALSE RUMORS AND TO DENOUNCE THE REAL TRAFFICKING, EVEN THOUGH IN REMOTE COUNTRIES."

IN TODAY'S PIECE, BIETRY FOCUSES ON KIDNEY DONATION, AND REPORTS ON "TOTALLY LEGAL INTERMEDIARIES" IN THE U.S.

PATRICK BOURRAT ON TV TF-1 YESTERDAY AT 8:00PM: "BILL CLINTON IS COMING EMPTY-HANDED, WITH HIS SUITCASE FULL OF ENCOURAGEMENT, RECOMMENDATIONS, ADVICE FOR BORIS YELTSIN.... THE AMERICANS--WE KNEW IT--...ARE EXCELLENT AT LECTURING, BUT HAVE A HARD TIME OPENING THEIR WALLET."

DOMINIQUE DERDA ON TV FRANCE 2 THIS MORNING: "THEY (CLINTON AND YELTSIN) ALREADY LOOK AS TWO OLD FRIENDS GETTING TOGETHER AGAIN.... BILL CLINTON HAS APPARENTLY COME EMPTY-HANDED, WITH NO NEW FINANCIAL AID, DETERMINED TO PSYCHOLOGICALLY HELP MOSCOW SMOOTH THE EFFECT OF REFORMS ON THE MAN IN THE STREET.... IN THE LAND OF LOST ILLUSIONS, BILL CLINTON IS THE CHAMPION OF SELF-PERSUASION METHODS. THIS AFTERNOON, HE WILL REPEAT TO THE RUSSIANS: 'COURAGE, HOLD FIRM, THIS IS JUST A BAD TIME THAT WILL PASS.'"

STEPHANE MARCHAND REPORTS FROM MOSCOW IN CONSERVATIVE LE FIGARO: "...IN MOSCOW, THE AMERICAN PRESIDENT IS FACING AN UNCOMFORTABLE PARADOX. HE WANTS TO KEEP INTACT HIS SUPPORT FOR REFORMER PRESIDENT BORIS YELTSIN. BUT THE LATTER, IN ORDER TO PRESERVE HIS POWER, WILL INEVITABLY HAVE TO TAKE HIS DISTANCE FROM HIS U.S. COUNTERPART. THIS IS THE CONSEQUENCE OF THE RUSSIAN DECEMBER 12 ELECTIONS."

INFLUENTIAL LE MONDE MOSCOW CORRESPONDENT JAN KRAUZE: "...IN PRINCIPLE, THIS TWO-DAY, THREE-NIGHT VISIT WILL PROVIDE NEITHER SURPRISES NOR MAJOR RESULTS. INDEED, THE ESSENTIAL PART OF IT WAS (KNOWN) EVEN BEFORE MR. CLINTON SET FOOT ON RUSSIAN SOIL--I.E. THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION'S APPARENTLY UNFAILING SUPPORT FOR BORIS UNCLAS SECTION 03 OF 04 PARIS 01328

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YELTSIN...AND THE PRIORITY WASHINGTON CLEARLY GRANTS TO RUSSIA OVER THE OTHER FORMER SOVIET REPUBLICS AS WELL AS OVER EASTERN EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.... A PRIORITY AT THE VANCOUVER AND TOKYO SUMMITS, ECONOMIC AID TO RUSSIA HAS THIS TIME BEEN DELIBERATELY RELEGATED TO THE BACKGROUND. THE RUSSIANS, ESPECIALLY THE PUBLIC, DON'T VERY MUCH BELIEVE IN IT ANYMORE. TO FOCUS ON THIS QUESTION COULD NOT BUT GIVE ARGUMENTS TO BORIS YELTSIN'S OPPONENTS. THE AMERICANS ON THEIR PART, ALSO FOR DOMESTIC POLITICAL REASONS, DON'T WANT TO DRAW ON THEIR MONEY.... THE U.S. PRESIDENT INTENDS TO BE PERFECTLY CLEAR IN HIS ATTITUDE VIS-A-VIS THE MAN WHO WON THE ELECTIONS AND WITH WHOM YELTSIN HAS AMBIGUOUS RELATIONS (ZHIRINOV\$KY). BUT ONE CAN ALSO THINK THAT, BY REFUSING TO MEET THE NEW SPOKESMAN OF RUSSIAN NATIONALISM, MR. CLINTON IS RENDERING HIM A FAVOR, AND STRENGTHENS HIS POSITION IN PUBLIC OPINION."

PIERRE BRIANCON REPORTS FROM MOSCOW IN LIBERATION: "HE HAD COME TO MOSCOW BOTH TO SUPPORT BORIS YELTSIN AND TO SEE WHETHER HE IS RIGHT IN DOING SO. DURING THE FIRST HALF OF HIS VISIT, YESTERDAY, BILL CLINTON SEEMS TO HAVE TRIED TO REASSURE HIMSELF AS MUCH AS TO BE REASSURING. THE TALKS BETWEEN THE TWO PRESIDENTS WERE PLACED UNDER THE EARMARK OF OSTENTATIOUS HARMONY, SOME UNPRECEDENTED PLANS OF ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL COOPERATION, PROMISES FROM BOTH SIDES, AND A VISIBLE DESIRE NOT TO RAISE UNPLEASANT QUESTIONS.... STRATEGIC ISSUES WILL BE ON THE AGENDA TODAY.... THE THREE (U.S., RUSSIAN AND UKRAINIAN PRESIDENTS) WILL SIGN A DOCUMENT WHICH IS LIKELY TO BE VAGUE (ON UKRAINE'S DENUCLEARIZATION), BUT WHICH SEEMS TO SATISFY EVERYONE. PROBLEMS WILL BE FOR LATER."

MARIE-FRANCE CALLE REPORTS FROM MOSCOW IN ECONOMIC LES ECHOS: "THE U.S. PRESIDENT WILL NOT MEET WITH VLADIMIR ZHIRINOVSKY. HOWEVER, THE CONTENT OF BILL CLINTON'S MESSAGE TO HIS HOSTS HAS BEEN STRONGLY INFLUENCED BY THE ULTRA-NATIONALIST LEADER'S ELECTORAL SUCCESS (DEC. 12 ELECTIONS). FROM AN ECONOMIC POINT OF VIEW, FIRST. ON THAT QUESTION, MR. CLINTON SEEMS TO BE SATISFIED, FOR THE TIME BEING, WITH ONLY PURELY MORAL AND POLITICAL SUPPORT FOR BORIS YELTSIN, AND NO NEW ANNOUNCED FINANCIAL AID TO MOSCOW. ON SECURITY IN THE REGION, THE SIGNING OF A TRIPARTITE ACCORD WILL BE THE KEYNOTE OF THE PRESIDENTIAL VISIT, AND WILL IN A WAY MAKE UP FOR THE POOR ECONOMIC MESSAGE.... THE U.S. PRESIDENT'S MOMENT OF GLORY WILL BE AT THE SIGNING OF THE (UKRAINIAN DISARMAMENT) ACCORD. ITS TERMS ARE STILL CONFIDENTIAL. BUT SOURCES CLOSE TO BILL CLINTON SAID YESTERDAY THAT THE UNITED STATES IS READY TO GIVE \$117 MILLION TO RUSSIA AND UKRAINE TO HELP THEM FINANCE THE DISMANTLEMENT OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS."

PHILIPPE MARCOVICI IN RIGHT-OF-CENTER LE QUOTIDIEN:

"...THE DENUCLEARIZATION OF UKRAINE IS UNDOUBTEDLY THE

ESSENTIAL MOMENT OF THE MOSCOW SUMMIT. BUT WHATEVER THE ACCORD ON THIS ISSUE, LEONID KRAVCHUK--WHO IS NOT MORE STABLE IN KIEV THAN BORIS YELTSIN IN MOSCOW--WILL HAVE UNCLAS SECTION 04 OF 04 PARIS 01328

JEAN LESIEUR AND ALAIN LOUYOT CO-AUTHOR AN ARTICLE IN WEEKLY L'EXPRESS: "...UNDER STROBE TALBOTT'S IMPULSE, BILL CLINTON HAS DEFINED AT LEAST THE OUTLINES OF A DOCTRINE.... THE SECURITY OF RUSSIA'S NEIGHBORS PASSES BY THE SUCCESS OF THE YELTSIN TEAM, AND THEREFORE BY THE CONCESSIONS WHICH CLINTON SEEMS READY TO GRANT THEM. IT IS PROBABLY THERE THAT LIE THE OUTLINES OF A REAL U.S. FOREIGN POLICY DOCTRINE. TO THOSE WHO SAID THAT (U.S. FOREIGN POLICY) HAD DISAPPEARED WITH BUSH'S DEPARTURE, CLINTON ANSWERED GATT, NAFTA, OPENNESS TO ASIA. IN THAT REGARD, HE KEPT HIS CAMPAIGN PROMISES. SINCE THE RAISON D'ETRE OF HIS MANDATE IS TO CURB AMERICA'S-DECLINE, TO MAKE IT COMPETITIVE AGAIN IN WORLD MARKETS, (CLINTON) MUST FIGHT FOR THIS UNIQUE OBSESSION--TO ENCOURAGE, EVERYWHERE, THOSE WHO SUPPORT FREE ECONOMIES. AND IN MOSCOW, GORBACHEV'S SUCCESSOR IS THE ONLY ONE WHO SEEMS ABLE TO ENSURE THE TRANSITION IN A STABLE WAY.

CLINTON'S STRATEGY SEEMS A BIT RISKY. BECAUSE, BY DOING SO, WASHINGTON IS FORCED TO TAKE FOR GRANTED BORIS YELTSIN'S DEMOCRATIC DECLARATIONS OF INTENTION. BUT, EVEN SUPPORTED BY THE AMERICAN FRIEND, WILL YELTSIN BE ABLE TO KEEP HIS PROMISES? ALSO, IN THIS (U.S. FOREIGN POLICY) DOCTRINE, WHAT ABOUT BOSNIA, SOMALIA, HAITI, THESE 'MORAL' GREAT CAUSES OF WHICH...AMERICA HAS MADE ITSELF SO OFTEN THE CHAMPION?"

((Text)) ((Terenche)) Nevertheless, what is the explanation of the fact that Romania is constantly eschewed by U.S. officials?

((Melescanu)) A position toward Romania is valid. Therefore, I believe it is necessary to conduct a dialogue at the summit level and I mentioned the possibility of a meeting in Prague. Or an official visit, for which purpose I extended an invitation to President Clinton to visit Romania. The excuse was a full program and I am convinced that it was not a circumstantial problem. We have overcome the stage in which political dialogue at the summit level was a question of reservations by the other side...

((Terenche)) How did the Americans react to the election results in the Russian Federation?

((Melescanu)) I arrived there when things had begun to calm down. I said that not the result, but the percentage surprised us. Obviously, in Russia there is very broad support for tackling the reform other than in a democratic way. The conclusion I drew was that an alarm signal has been sounded and this should make the Americans pay greater attention to the support granted to Russia and the East European countries.

((Terenche)) What was the reaction to the death sentence pronounced in the Ilie Ilascu case?

((Melescanu)) The entire Romanian community in the United States rallied and energetically supported the Ilascu case. They took steps and put pressure on the U.S. Administration.

((Terenche)) And what was the result?

((Melescanu)) The result is a very serious involvement of the Administration. We have already received serious signals in this respect from Moscow. In the United States it is very important when an ethnic community rallies and demands something from the Administration. For ourselves, however, that is for relations with Russia this has, unfortunately, had a negative effect. The postponement of the visit by Defense Minister Grachev is a signal in this respect. And such signals have become increasingly numerous: For example, the postponement of the meeting on the treasury or the consultations on the treaty... I personally do not think that we are guilty of anything, because what happened in Tiraspol was shocking for the public, irrespective of political leaning. People were shocked and said so. But this created a negative moment in Romanian-Russian relations as far as economic integration is concerned. It is important for us to relaunch bilateral relations with our neighbors: With Bulgaria, Ukraine, and, of course, with the Russian Federation. Such moments affect us. They have a much more centralized system than we, where every economic element has a political effect.

((Terenche)) You also hold the position of minister state secretary, that is a sort of deputy prime minister. What are you doing in this capacity?

((Melescanu)) A sort of... is well put. We have the feeling, somehow, that we could do more to brief and ensure the access of parliamentarians and politicians to the foreign policy elements such as the European conventions.

((Terenche)) But here we can also mention the way in which one can violate the freedom of citizens to travel, a right enshrined in the European conventions, which are so little known by our authorities... I am referring to the refusal of granting a visa to His Majesty King Mihai to visit the country on 1 December.

((Melescanu)) There are two aspects: First, there is the formal one, meaning the need to clearly settle procedures. Irrespective of what will happen, of how we will develop politically, we have to try to solve the problem of the monarchy in its entirety. I want you to understand me: It is not the visa that presents a problem, but the political decision on the king's participation in some of the events in the country. I understand that there was an opening at Christmas, but there was no answer. I am not talking about the fact that we are a republic; that is clear and stipulated in the constitution.

((Terenche)) But nothing is nailed...

((Melescanu)) Of course. But I do not understand why we do not see the good side of things in this respect. A major part of the Romanians, who left the country after the war, did not do so because

they had it too good. If we start from the idea that now we need the support of Romanians everywhere, I do not see why we should not consider the possibility of using the royal institution. Especially since reference was made to abiding by the constitution. This is why we are the advocates of solving this problem in its entirety. We need the support of numerous capitals through contacts.

"HOW FAR SHOULD NATO GO?"

"THE CLOSER THE NATO SUMMIT NEXT MONDAY COMES, THE MORE THE SPECULATIONS ABOUT THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT IN RUSSIA ARE RUNNING WILD, AND THE MORE PRESSING BECOME THE QUESTIONS ON WHAT NATO INTENDS TO DO.... THE POLITICALLY RESPONSIBLE OFFICIALS IN THE ALLIANCE WHO HAVE TO MAKE A DECISION ARE NOT TO BE ENVIED, SINCE, WHATEVER THEY DO, THEY WILL HAVE TO ACCEPT CONSIDERABLE RISKS. THE RISK IS NOT SO MUCH THAT A REARMED RUSSIA COULD ONE DAY ATTACK WESTERN EUROPE, BUT THAT AN IMPERIAL RUSSIA COULD TRY TO PUT THE ALLIANCE TO THE TEST.

"IN JUNE OF 1991, NATO'S FOREIGN MINISTERS STATED IN COPENHAGEN: 'OUR SECURITY IS INSEPARABLY LINKED TO THE SECURITY OF ALL OTHER EUROPEAN NATIONS.' IF THIS IS NOT TO BE AN EMPTY PHRASE, THEY MUST NOW MAKE UP THEIR MINDS AND FIND OUT WHAT THIS MEANS.
