[FBIS Translated Text] Defense Space Policy and Its Integration
With National Space Policy [subhead]

The defense industry is one of the major users of the country's space capability. In its specific areas of interest, Defense Ministry initiatives will have to be independently financed and organized. Considerable savings can be achieved in the development and exploitation of space systems in dual-purpose sectors by coordinating policies.

Reorganization of the Procedures and Means for Space Policy
Definition [subhead]

The space industry requires reorganization at two levels:

-- The first is the political and strategic level, with coordination and monitoring centering on the Interministerial Committee on Space (CIS) backed up by a Space Board;

-- The second is the operational and technical management level, comprising ASI and the operational and technical management departments of the ministries that finance space programs.

Without amending Act 186/88, ASI should reorganize internally, appointing two directors answerable to the director general: one for national and international scientific programs, and the other for national and international applications/industrial programs, both having ample autonomous decisionmaking powers.

Financial Resources and Allocation to Major Goals [subhead]

The ASI administrator extraordinary must take three measures immediately:

1. At the purely administrative level, the programs must be carried out on a strictly contractual basis in accordance with the regulations currently in force;

2. At the technical management level, as far as national and joint programs are concerned, there must be an overall renegotiation with industry or, where appropriate, recourse must be had to administrative tribunals and the programs referred to in the last three sections of Annex 7 canceled;

3. External auditors must be called in to ascertain the deficit as of 31 December 1995.

As far as Italy's participation in optional ESA programs and the joint space station program with the United States are concerned, the commitment must be reduced to the lowest possible level.

The "Committee of Five" has nevertheless had to take note of the "political" decisions adopted by the Council of Ministers of the ESA member states in Granada (1992) and Toulouse (October 1995).

These decisions are to some extent in conflict with the recommendations set out above, so the new ASI -- whose organizational structure was outlined in Chapter 8 -- will have to draw up its operational plans in such a way as to bring our country's space programs back into line with the Outline Plan drawn up by the Committee of Five in the shortest time possible.

Indeed, this is deemed possible provided courageous, well-directed decisions are made, both on existing programs and on those about to be launched, with a view to obtaining real scientific, technological, and industrial returns commensurate with the country's level of investment in this sector.

This is the only way that the enormous investment that Italy has made in the space sector in the past and plans to make in the future can have the indispensable positive repercussions on the "quality" and "quantity" of the gains in terms of employment.
