Coalition whip Ofir Pines-Paz (One Israel) said that he would

not be summoning any ministers or MKs back from the summit for the vote.

"We don't participate in their dirty game," he said,

adding that the

factions had broken parliamentary custom and

are trying to "sabotage

the summit by cheap tricks."

The National Union-Yisra'el Beytenu motion is against the

"security

risks" being posed against the country by the summit. In

his

motion, Kleiner calls for no confidence in Baraq over what he said

was the offer to "give billions of shekels to the Arab sector"

in an

attempt to obtain their votes, especially at a time when

they are becoming

more "pro- Palestinian and anti-Israeli."

Likud whip Rubi Rivlin also thought about submitting a no-confidence motion next, but party leader Ari'el Sharon rejected the idea since Baraq is abroad. The Likud does intend, however, to file a motion as soon as Baraq returns, party spokesman Ofir Okunis said yesterday. [Description of Source: Jerusalem The Jerusalem Post in English -- Independent]

TOP STORIES IN THE PRESS. (7/14)

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1. INDEPENDENT, MODERATE AL-QUDS REPORTED ON ITS FRONT PAGE UNDER THE HEADLINE "ARAFAT AND BARAK DISCUSS THE JERUSALEM ISSUE AND IDEAS FOR EXCHANGING LANDS," SAYING THAT SOURCES IN THE DEMOCRATIC FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF PALESTINE SAID THAT THE ISRAELI DELEGATION SUBMITTED WORK PAPERS STIPULATING THE EXCHANGE OF THE REFUGEE'S RIGHT OF RETURN FOR THE RECOGNITION OF ISRAEL OF THE PALESTINIAN STATE, TO BE DECLARED ON SEPTEMBER 13.

2. AL-QUDS WROTE REPORTED MEDIA SOURCES QUOTING PALESTINIAN OFFICIALS AT CAMP DAVID SAYING THAT CHAIRMAN ARAFAT MIGHT STOP THE TALKS IF THE AMERICAN ADMINISTRATION REFUSES TO ALLOW MEMBERS OF THE PALESTINIAN LEADERSHIP TO ENTER CAMP DAVID.

3. SEMI-OFFICIAL AL-HAYAT AL-JADIDA REPORTED THAT ISRAELI OFFICIALS SAID YESTERDAY THAT PEACE TALKS IN CAMP DAVID MIGHT DISCUSS THE ISSUE OF EXCHANGING LANDS, ALLOWING ISRAEL TO KEEP JEWISH SETTLEMENTS IN THE WEST BANK IN RETURN FOR TRANSFERRING LAND INSIDE OF ISRAEL TO THE PALESTINIANS. A SENIOR ISRAELI OFFICIAL SAID THAT PALESTINIANS TOLD ISRAEL SECRETLY THAT THEY MIGHT GIVE UP SETTLEMENTS AROUND JERUSALEM AND IN GOSH AND IN THE WEST BANK IF THEY ARE GIVEN ISRAELI LANDS NEAR GAZA.

4. AL-HAYAT AL-JADIDA REPORTED THAT HANNA ATALLAH, CLERGYMAN AND SPOKESMAN AT THE GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH IN JERUSALEM AND THE HOLY LANDS, STRESSED THE NEED TO EXERT PRESSURE ON THE ISRAELI SIDE IN THE CAMP DAVID NEGOTIATIONS. HE SAID THAT ANY PEACE THAT IS NOT

BASED ON  
PALESTINIANS REGAINING THEIR FULL RIGHTS IN  
JERUSALEM  
WILL NOT STAND THE CHALLENGES OF THE FUTURE.

5. VOICE OF PALESTINE RADIO QUOTED SALIM AL-  
ZA'NOUN,  
SPEAKER OF THE PALESTINIAN NATIONAL COUNCIL, AS  
SAYING  
THAT DIFFERENCES STILL EXIST BETWEEN BOTH THE  
PALESTINIAN

AND ISRAELI NEGOTIATORS BECAUSE THE ISRAELI  
NEGOTIATORS  
HAVE CARRIED THEIR 'NO'S' TO WASHINGTON. AL-  
ZA'NOUN  
EXPRESSED HOPES THAT BARAK'S 'NO'S' ARE FOR  
TACTICAL  
REASONS ONLY. THE RADIO ALSO QUOTED THE  
SPOKESWOMAN FOR  
THE PALESTINIAN NEGOTIATING TEAM TO CAMP DAVID,  
HANAN  
ASHRAWI, AS SAYING THAT THE AMERICAN  
ADMINISTRATION SHOULD  
ADOPT A DECISIVE POSITION, WHICH WOULD CONFORM  
WITH THE

THE ISRAEL DELEGATES ARE FREE TO ROAM AROUND AND SAY ANYTHING THEY WANT.
