Dear Mr. Chairman:

I have given a lot of thought to the Camp David Summit since we departed, and while I continue to feel deeply disappointed at its outcome, I also remain hopeful that we can reach a historic agreement in the coming weeks.

In order to achieve that goal, however, it is imperative that Israelis and Palestinians create a positive atmosphere and prepare their people for the courageous decisions that will have to be taken by both sides.

In that context, I must tell you that I was extremely disappointed by

the
speeches you have given upon your return. They run counter to the
spirit of our
last discussions in which it was understood that both sides would
avoid using
inflammatory rhetoric in the aftermath of the Summit.

Mr. Chairman, you know how much I want to help you and the
Palestinian people
realize their legitimate aspirations. And you know that I continue to
believe
that an honorable agreement remains possible and within reach. But if
Palestinian officials continue to make such statements, it will be
impossible for
me to play a constructive role and to persevere in my efforts. I am
counting on
you to address this issue as promptly as you can. The future of the
peace
process, to a large extent, depends on it.

SUBJECT: Letter from Representative Callahan

Purpose

Respond to a letter from Representative Callahan.

Background

Representative Callahan wrote with a request concerning possible assistance to the parties in the event of an Israeli-Palestinian peace agreement. He suggests that you encourage "project-specific" assistance rather than an overall lump-sum so that we could better justify the amounts being provided.

Your response reiterates that we will consult thoroughly with the Congress before making any commitment and notes that you will keep his suggestion in mind.

Dear Representative Callahan:

Thank you for your letter regarding our efforts in the Middle East Peace Process and for your kind words of encouragement.

While the Camp David Summit ended without an agreement, I am convinced that it was an important step on the road toward peace. Both Israelis and Palestinians discussed issues that had not been discussed beforehand, and both were willing to entertain creative suggestions to end their conflict. To the extent that the Summit changed the terms of reference of their debate and opened up new horizons, it was an important achievement. Now, both Prime Minister Barak and Chairman Arafat need to reflect on what happened at Camp David and on what needs to take place if they are to reach an agreement.

With regard to any possible U.S. assistance to the parties, and although preliminary discussions did take place, we made it clear that we would not make any commitment absent thorough consultation with the Congress. In the event the parties are able to make further progress and move closer to an agreement, I will certainly keep your request regarding project-specific assistance in mind.

Once again, thank you for your interest in this matter.
