DRAFT GUIDANCE -- Please pass to Tony Lake for clearance:

-- The President is delighted by the announcement that King Hussein and Prime Minister Rabin have reached agreement today on the text of a Jordan-Israel peace treaty.

-- King Hussein and Prime Minister Rabin called the President on Air Force One this morning to tell him their good news. They both thanked the President for his assistance in bringing about their agreement and invited him to join them at the signing ceremony on October 26 as their "partner in ratifying the agreement."

-- The President congratulated both leaders on their courage and vision and told them that America was cheering for them. He said he would give serious consideration to their invitation.

Q: When will the President decide?

A: As the President said, he is giving serious consideration to the invitation. It was just issued this morning. He will have to look at the calendar which was already very full for October.

Q: Is the crisis with Iraq over?

A: The Iraqi Republican Guard units have started to move out of Nasariyah. We are continuing to watch this closely. The crisis will not be over until they return to their positions north of the 32nd parallel and we have assured ourselves that Iraq will not again be in a position to threaten its neighbors.

Q: Any change in the deployment of U.S. forces?

A: We are continuing to flow forces into the region.
