MEMORANDUM FOR THE HEADS OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

Subject: Streamlining the Granting of Waivers

Five years ago, the Vice President asked you to create reinvention laboratories in your departments and agencies and to streamline the granting of waivers of internal agency rules within them so the

laboratories could more effectively promote innovation. These waivers -- delegations of authority to deviate from existing internal agency policies and procedures -- are often sought by front-line employees who are trying to make their operations work better, cost less, and get results that Americans care about. The Vice President and I emphasized such measures in the Blair House Papers last year, when we encouraged you to delegate more power to front-line employees to unlock the enormous potential of the Federal workforce.

Your departments and agencies have responded, and Federal employees have used waivers to facilitate innovation and provide excellent customer service. For example, the Coast Guard marine safety programs have increased managerial flexibility for field commanders to waive unnecessary requirements that had previously accounted for over one-half million work hours annually. The Department of Agriculture's Animal Plant Health Inspection Service's Tort Claims Adjudication Team used a waiver to reduce the processing time for tort claims of less than \$2,500 from 51 days to 8.

Based on these experiences, I am directing you, where you determine that it is appropriate, to adopt some of the best practices developed by agencies. These best practices include the following characteristics:

1. Waiver requests are acted upon within 30 days or less. After 30 days, the originating entity within the agency can assume approval and implement the requested waiver.
2. Those officials having authority to grant or change internal agency rules can approve waiver requests, but only the head of an agency can deny a waiver request.
3. Officials who have the authority to grant waivers are encouraged to identify potential waiver opportunities and extend waivers to their own agencies.

The Vice President's team at the National Partnership for Reinventing Government (NPR) is ready to assist you in developing a waiver process based upon lessons learned and best practices from agencies that have experience with waivers. Some of you already have this type of waiver process in place for reinvention laboratories. I direct you to take every opportunity to extend this process throughout your agency.

PRESIDENT CLINTON AND VICE PRESIDENT GORE'S
ACCOMPLISHMENTS: *California*

EXPANDING ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL

- **Unemployment Down to 5.8%:** The unemployment rate in California has declined from 9.7% to 5.8% since 1993.
- **1,340,200 New Jobs:** 1,340,200 new jobs have been created in California since 1993 -- an average of 263,646 jobs per year. In contrast, an average of 11,350 jobs were lost each year during the previous administration.
- **1,264,800 New Private Sector Jobs:** Since 1993, 1,264,800 new private sector jobs have been created -- an average of 248,813 jobs per year, compared to an average loss of 38,600 private sector jobs per year in the previous administration.
- **96,200 New Manufacturing Jobs:** 96,200 manufacturing jobs have been created in California since 1993 -- an average of 18,925 jobs per year. In contrast, an average of 66,475 manufacturing jobs were lost each year during the previous administration.
- **145,300 New Construction Jobs:** 145,300 construction jobs have been created in California since 1993 -- an average of 28,584 jobs per year. In contrast, an average of 28,025 construction jobs were lost each year during the previous administration.
- **Business Failures Down to 0.5% Per Year:** Business failures have decreased to an average of 0.5% per year since 1993, after increasing 21.8% per year during the previous 12 years.
- **1.2 Million Have Received a Raise:** 999,000 California workers benefited from an increase in the minimum wage -- from \$4.25 to \$4.75 -- on October 1, 1996. They, along with 200,000 more, received an additional raise -- from \$4.75 to \$5.15 -- on September 1, 1997.
- **Home Building Up 2.1%:** Home building has increased by an average of 2.1% per year since 1993, after falling over 21.2% per year during the previous administration.
- **A \$500 Child Tax Credit to Help Families Raising Children:** To help make it easier for families to raise their children, the balanced budget includes a \$500 per-child tax credit for children under 17. **Thanks to President Clinton, the balanced budget delivers a child tax credit to 3,229,000 families in California.**
- **Over \$40,000 of Reduced Federal Debt for Every Family of Four:** The national debt will be more than \$2.5 trillion lower in 2002 than was projected before the passage of President Clinton's economic plan. That's over \$40,000 of reduced federal debt for each family of four in California.

EXPANDING ACCESS TO EDUCATION

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- **\$509 Million in Head Start Funding:** In FY97, California received nearly \$459 million in Head Start funding benefitting nearly 80,000 children. This year, California receives \$509 million for Head Start, an increase of \$50 million over 1997. President Clinton's FY99 budget proposal will increase Head Start funding for California's children by an additional \$41 million.
- **\$54.8 Million in Goals 2000 Funding:** This year [FY98], California receives \$54.8 million in Goals 2000 funding. This money is used to raise academic achievement by raising academic standards, increasing parental and community involvement in education, expanding the use of computers and technology in classrooms, and supporting high-quality teacher professional development.
- **\$46.6 Million for Technology Literacy:** This year [FY98], California receives \$46.6 million --more than doubling its funding over FY97 -- for the Technology Literacy Challenge Fund which helps communities and the private sector ensure that every student is equipped with the computer literacy skills needed for the 21st century. President Clinton's FY99 budget proposal will raise funding for technology literacy by \$5 million over FY98.
- **Nearly \$830 Million for Students Most in Need:** California receives \$829.5 million in Title I Grants (to Local Educational Agencies) providing extra help in the basics for students most in need, particularly communities and schools with high concentrations of children in low-income families [FY98]. President Clinton's FY99 budget proposes to increase funding for Title I Grants by \$95 million to aid California's students.
- **\$877.6 Million in Pell Grants:** This year [FY98], California will receive \$877.6 million in Pell Grants for low-income students going to college, an additional \$170.3 million over last year. With this increase, a total of 439,800 California students will benefit, 25,400 more than the previous year. And President Clinton's FY99 budget proposal increases Pell Grant funding to \$907.4 million.
- **Over 11,300 Have Served in California through AmeriCorps:** Since the National Service program began in 1993, over 11,300 AmeriCorps participants, working in 640 different programs, have earned money for college while working in California's schools, hospitals, neighborhoods or parks [through 3/98].
- **Tuition Tax Credits in Balanced Budget Open the Doors of College and Promote Lifelong Learning:** The balanced budget includes both President Clinton's \$1,500 HOPE Scholarship to help make the first two years of college as universal as a high school diploma and a Lifetime Learning Tax Credit for college juniors, seniors, graduate students and working Americans pursuing lifelong learning to upgrade their skills. This 20% tax credit will be applied to the first \$5,000 of tuition and fees through 2002 and to the first \$10,000 thereafter. **761,000 students in California will receive a HOPE Scholarship tax credit of up to \$1,500. 934,000 students in California will receive the Lifetime Learning Tax Credit.**

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FIGHTING CRIME AND VIOLENCE

- **Crime Falls 19% in California:** Since 1992, serious crime has fallen 26% in Long Beach, 31% in Los Angeles, 12% in Sacramento, 33% in San Diego, 26% in San Francisco, and 14% in San Jose **and serious crime has fallen 19% statewide.** [1996 data].
- **8,933 More Police:** The President's 1994 Crime Bill has funded 8,933 new police officers in communities across California [through 4/98].
- **Over \$13 Million to Combat Domestic Violence:** Through the Violence Against Women Act, California receives \$13,327,000 in federal funds this year [FY98] to establish more women's shelters and bolster law enforcement, prosecution, and victims' services.
- **\$6,810,844 in Grants for Battered Women and Children:** This year [FY98], California will receive \$6,810,844 in HHS's Family Violence Prevention Program grants to assist women and children fleeing domestic abuse, an additional \$1.2 million increase over last year. President Clinton's FY99 budget proposal increases HHS's Family Violence Prevention Program grants to nearly \$7 million.
- **\$59.5 Million to Keep Drugs & Violence Out of California's Schools:** California receives \$59.5 million in FY98 for the Safe & Drug Free Schools Program, which invests in school security and drug prevention programs.

MOVING CALIFORNIANS FROM WELFARE TO WORK

- **189,228 Fewer on Welfare:** There are currently 189,228 fewer people on welfare than there were in the beginning of 1993 -- a 8% decrease. [through 9/97].
- **Child Support Collections Up 38%:** Child support collections have increased by over \$249 million -- or 38% -- in California since FY92. [through FY96]
- **California Receives \$189 Million in Welfare-to-Work Grants:** In FY98, California will receive \$189 million in welfare-to-work state formula grants, helping California prepare welfare recipients for work and to place them in jobs. Part of the President's comprehensive efforts to move recipients from welfare to work, this funding is included in the \$3 billion Welfare-to-Work Jobs Challenge Fund signed into law in the 1997 balanced budget.

INVESTING IN CALIFORNIA'S HEALTH

- **Health Care for Uninsured Children:** The balanced budget includes the largest single investment in health care for children since the passage of Medicaid in 1965 -- an unprecedented \$24 billion over five years to cover as many as five million children throughout the nation. This investment guarantees the full range of benefits -- from checkups to surgery -- that children need to grow up strong and healthy. It ensures that prescription drugs, vision, hearing, and mental health coverage now offered at the state level are extended to millions of uninsured children. **To expand health coverage to more than 1.2 million uninsured children in California the balanced budget provides \$855 million in 1998. This compares to the 1995 Republican plan vetoed by President Clinton that would have denied health care coverage to 356,600 children in California.**
- **Helping California Women and Children with WIC:** The Clinton Administration is

committed to full funding in the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC). Last year, in California, 402,496 more women and children in need received health and food assistance than in 1994.

- **More Toddlers Are Being Immunized:** As a result of the President's 1993 Childhood Immunization Initiative, childhood immunization rates have reached an historic high. According to the CDC, 90% or more of America's toddlers in 1996 received the most critical doses of each of the routinely recommended vaccines -- surpassing the President's 1993 goal. In California in 1996, 94% of two-year olds received the vaccines for diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis; 91% received the vaccine for polio; 90% received the vaccine for measles, and 90% received the vaccine for *Haemophilus influenzae* B, the bacteria causing a form of meningitis.
- **President's Tobacco Plan Will Cut Smoking and Premature Deaths by 40% in California:** If the Clinton Administration's tobacco proposal on youth smoking is enacted, by 2003, California will see a 40% cut in youth smoking and resulting premature deaths. Over the next five years, 248,000 young Californians will be kept from smoking and 83,000 will be spared a premature tobacco-related death. [Treasury Dept., 3/23/98]

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

- **14 Toxic Waste Sites Cleaned Up:** Since 1993, the EPA has completed 14 Superfund toxic waste cleanups in California, in Sunnyvale (3), Santa Clara (2), Porterville, Coalinga, Palo Alto, Richmond, Oroville, Cloverdale, Fillmore, Riverbank, and Scotts Valley [through 1/98]. Only 14 sites were cleaned up in the previous 12 years combined.
- **Revitalizing 11 Brownfields in California:** Part of the Clinton-Gore Administration's efforts to clean up Brownfields, the EPA has designated 11 communities in California -- East Palo Alto, Emeryville, Oakland, Pomona, Richmond, Sacramento, San Diego, San Francisco, Santa Barbara County, Los Angeles and Stockton -- for environmental clean-up and economic revitalization. These projects are intended to jump-start local clean-up efforts by providing funds to return unproductive, abandoned, contaminated urban properties to productive use.

SPEARHEADING URBAN RENEWAL EFFORTS

- **\$128 Million to Los Angeles:** Los Angeles/ Huntington Park was designated an enterprise community in December, 1994 and was awarded \$3 million to create more jobs, housing, and economic opportunity for city residents. Later, it was designated a

Supplemental Empowerment Zone and was awarded \$125 million for similar job creation efforts.

- **\$28 Million to Oakland:** Oakland was designated an Enterprise Community in December 1994, and was awarded \$3 million to create economic opportunity for area residents. Later, it was designated an enhanced enterprise community and was awarded an additional \$25 million.
- **\$12 Million to Other Communities Across California:** Additionally, Imperial County, San Diego, San Francisco, and Watsonville were all designated Enterprise Communities and were each awarded \$3 million for job creation efforts.
- **Expanding the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Will Help Develop 12,700 To 15,200 New Affordable Housing Units in California Over the Next 5 years:** In January, the Vice-President announced the Clinton-Gore Administration's proposed 40-percent expansion of the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit. If enacted, it will mean an additional 12,700 - 15,200 quality rental housing units for low-income American families in California during the next five years.

EXPANDING FUNDS FOR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT

- **Nearly \$9.5 Billion in Federal Highway Aid:** Since 1993, California has received \$9.46 billion in federal highway aid. These funds have helped generate nearly 400,000 jobs (through FY97).
- **Over \$800 Million in Aviation Funds:** From FY93-FY97 California received \$825,560,000 in AIP funds to help build and renovate airports, and, when necessary, to provide funds for noise abatement to improve the quality of life for residents who live near airports.
- **Over \$1 Billion in Transit Funds:** California has received a total of \$1.1 billion in FTA funds since 1993.
- **\$15 Million for Soundproofing:** In April 1997, the city of Los Angeles announced the establishment of the LAX Airport Residential Soundproofing Bureau (ARSB) to expedite noise abatement actions that will ultimately soundproof about 9,000 homes. The ARSB has allocated \$15 million for Phase I of this project involving approximately 1,500 homes.
- **\$2.3 Million to Improve Transit for Low-Income Communities:** In July 1994, a Letter of No Prejudice was issued for \$2.3 million to LACMTA for the Los Angeles Neighborhood Initiative (LANI) which is a two-year transit-based demonstration program covering eight transit dependent, low-income LA communities.
- **\$750 to Improve Transit to the Airport:** On June 30, 1997, FTA committed \$750 million in New Starts funds over an eight year period to provide mass

transit to San Francisco Airport (SFO).

MEMORANDUM FOR HEADS OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

SUBJECT: Designation of Interagency Committees
to Facilitate and Encourage Agency Use of
Alternate Means of Dispute Resolution and
Negotiated Rulemaking

As part of an effort to make the Federal Government operate in a more efficient and effective manner, and to encourage, where possible, consensual resolution of disputes and issues in controversy involving the United States, including the prevention and avoidance of disputes, I have determined that each Federal agency must take steps to: (1) promote

greater use of mediation, arbitration, early neutral evaluation, agency ombuds, and other alternative dispute resolution techniques, and (2) promote greater use of negotiated rulemaking.

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and laws of the United States including sections 569(a) and 573(c) of title 5, United States Code, as amended by the Administrative Dispute Resolution Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-320), I hereby direct as follows:

An Alternative Dispute Resolution Working Group, comprised of the Cabinet Departments and, as determined by the Attorney General, such other agencies with a significant interest in dispute resolution, shall be convened and is designated under 5 U.S.C. 573(c) as the interagency committee to facilitate and encourage agency use of alternative means of dispute resolution. The Working Group shall consist of representatives of the heads of all participating agencies, and may meet as a whole or in subgroups of agencies with an interest in particular issues or subject areas, such as disputes involving personnel, procurement, and claims. The Working Group shall be convened by the Attorney General, who may designate a representative to convene and facilitate meetings of the subgroups. The Working Group shall facilitate, encourage, and provide coordination for agencies in such areas as: (1) development of programs that employ alter-native means of dispute resolution, (2) training of agency personnel to recognize when and how to use alternative means of dispute resolution, (3) development of procedures that permit agencies to obtain the services of neutrals on an expedited basis, and (4) recordkeeping to ascertain the benefits of alternative means of dispute resolution. The Working Group shall also periodically advise the President, through the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, on its activities.

The Regulatory Working Group established under section 4(d) of Executive Order 12866 is designated under 5 U.S.C. 569(a) as the interagency committee to facilitate and encourage agency use of negotiated rulemaking.

This directive is for the internal management of the executive branch and does not create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable by a party against the United States, its agencies or instrumentalities, its officers or employees, or any other person.

STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

Today, I have signed into law H.R. 3579, the FY 1998 Supplemental Appropriations and Rescissions Bill. This emergency supplemental legislation makes urgently needed funds available for victims of natural disasters and for our troops in Bosnia and Iraq. While it is disappointing that Congress has failed to meet the nation's financial responsibilities by not approving funds for the United Nations and the International Monetary Fund, Congress has provided urgently needed funds that I requested for victims of natural disasters at home and our military troops overseas.

I am pleased that this legislation will enable us to meet our commitment to our troops in Bosnia and the Persian Gulf, to support readiness worldwide, and to aid victims of natural disasters at home. This bill provides more than \$2 billion for these purposes.

The bill also includes \$2.4 billion for disaster relief programs for the Federal Emergency Management Administration, for emergency highway repair, for repairing levees and other flood control systems, for repairing national wildlife refuges and national park property and for state and private forestry, farm loans, dairy assistance and other agricultural assistance.

I am also pleased that Congress has decided to omit a number of extraneous and objectionable items in this legislation, such as provisions to increase the number of assault weapons on the street, to subsidize banks excessively for making student loans without fully offsetting the costs, and to undermine our ability to provide food stamps to certain legal immigrants. The omission of such items is appropriate, given the nature of this emergency supplemental legislation.

However, it is regrettable that Congress has again added anti-environmental measures in a much-needed appropriations bill, thereby overriding sound science with politics. One such provision permits the building of a highway through New Mexico's National Petroglyph Monument, representing an unwise precedent for removing nationally significant lands from an established monument to accommodate narrow concerns. Another provision interferes with the Forest Service's proposal to implement a temporary suspension of new road construction in the roadless areas of our national forests. In addition, I am very concerned about the limitations placed on the Government's ability to ensure a fair return for oil and gas resources extracted from Federal lands. My Administration will oppose any efforts to make them permanent.

I am deeply disappointed that this Act extends the comment period and delays the effective date of the "Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network" final rule, allowing an unfair organ allocation system to continue. This inequitable system violates the intent of the National Organ Transplant Act, which requires a national, equitable system, free of geographic bias, as well as the American Medical Association's Code of Medical Ethics, which prohibits the distribution of organs on the basis of geographic conditions. The final rule would ensure that organs are allocated to the sickest candidates first.

It is also regrettable that in order to pay for the emergency funding for victims of natural disasters, this legislation demands unnecessary and unwarranted cuts in existing housing programs for low-income Americans. Following our strong objections, Congress has pledged to restore this funding fully in the next fiscal year. I call upon Congress to honor that promise, and to do so without draining resources from any of the housing programs contained in my budget for FY 1999. Instead of cutting housing assistance to low-income Americans, Congress should provide funding for the 100,000 new housing vouchers proposed in my FY 1999 Budget.

It is now imperative that Congress act quickly so that we may meet our commitment to the U.N. and the IMF. Failure to provide the full request for U.N. arrears could jeopardize our chance to affect negotiations starting in May on lowering U.S. dues and would undermine U.S. leadership in the international community. In addition, delay or failure to meet the full IMF requests could undermine our capacity to deal with threats to world economic stability and could leave us unable to protect American workers, farmers, and businesses in the event of an escalation or spread of the Asian financial crisis or a new crisis. I call on Congress to pass new legislation quickly and with workable terms so that the United States is able to maintain its position as a world leader and to meet its obligations to the United Nations and the International Monetary Fund.

CEQ COMMENTS ON SIGNING STATEMENT

It is very troubling that Congress placed politics above sound science by insisting on two measures that would promote paving our public lands with roads. One of these provisions permits the building of a six-lane commuter highway near Albuquerque, New Mexico through the Petroglyph National Monument, created to protect sacred Native American sites. This is an unfortunate example of Washington politicians dictating to communities instead of listening to them, including in this case many local citizens, tribal leaders, the Mayor of Albuquerque, and the local Superintendent of the Monument. This is a dangerous departure from the practice of managing National Parks based on sound science and resource protection. I will work to ensure that this is not repeated.

Another egregious section is intended to interfere with the Forest Service's ability to manage the national forests. This rider is directed at a proposed regulation related to temporary suspension of road construction in roadless areas on our national forests before the regulation is even final. It imposes costly, difficult and burdensome paperwork and compensation requirements on the Forest Service. However, it does afford some discretion to the Chief of the Forest Service, and I am directing the Chief to exercise that discretion in a manner that minimizes interruption to the implementation of the management of the national forests, including any policy or regulation related to road construction.

Here are my comments to Rahm, Bruce and Elena. I didn't hear back from everyone, but Bruce thought this was on the mark. Hope it's not too late.

1. National Rollout of the Youth Media Campaign. We should support a roll-out of this signature anti-drug initiative. However, for the President not to be disappointed, we need to make sure Rahm takes the lead in getting ONDCP to come up with some specific announcements -- i.e., new anti-drug ads, additional private sector partners and commitments, results from the 6-month/12-city pilot, etc.

2. U.N. Special Session on Drugs. I understand scheduling has already committed to do this, and that NSC is taking the lead. There is very little of our stuff here.

3. Drug-Free Communities Rollout. The President just signed off on the proposed candidates for the Drug-Free Communities board, and Personnel says that it will take another 4 to 6 weeks to fully vet these folks. I would not, however, recommend this as a stand-alone event. The board does not include any really big names, and the grants are so small (\$10 million). Moreover, the Hill Dems were not happy when we did a signing ceremony with the R's on this. They hate that the R's vote against funding for virtually every other community-based drug program -- to the tune of hundreds of millions of dollars -- and then turn around and

support these tiny grants for community organizations. If anything, we should roll this into the media campaign announcement. It will allow us to say we're linking our national ant-drug message with action at the grass roots.

4. President's Drug Advisory Council. This is a bit of a problem. As I've mentioned, OMB -- for themselves and on behalf of various agencies -- has expressed serious concerns about ONDCP wanting to discuss its performance measurement system at this meeting. I would defer to them on when it's appropriate to do this.

SUBJECT: Plain Language in Written Government Communications

The Vice President and I have made reinventing the Federal Government a top priority of my Administration. We are determined to make the Federal Government more responsive and more accessible to its customers, the American people. How your departments and agencies communicate with ordinary citizens is a critical part of our efforts.

It is essential that Federal Government writing be in plain language. By using plain language, we help citizens to understand our documents. Plain language conveys a clear message about what the Government is doing, what it requires, and what services it offers. Although plain language may vary in different documents, such documents are always organized logically, focus on the reader, and generally use:

- common, everyday words, except for necessary technical terms;
- "you" and other pronouns that speak to the intended readers;
- the active voice; and
- short sentences.

To ensure the use of plain language in Federal documents, I hereby direct you as follows:

First, after October 1, 1999, your department or agency shall use plain language in all non-rulemaking documents published in the Federal Register.

Second, after January 1, 2000, your department or agency shall use plain language in all proposed and final rulemaking documents published in the Federal Register, including all amendments to rules.

Third, as soon as practicable, your department or agency shall use plain language in all other documents that explain how to obtain a benefit or service from your agency, or comply with a requirement your agency administers or enforces.

Fourth, by January 1, 2002, your department or agency shall use plain language to rewrite, where appropriate, existing regulations and other documents, especially those that affect large numbers of people.

Fifth, your department or agency shall use customer feedback to improve your plain language efforts and to identify those existing documents that most need rewriting.

Sixth, your department or agency shall include in Regulatory Plans submitted after November 1, 1999, a description of your efforts to write regulations in plain language.

This Executive memorandum does not confer any right or benefit enforceable by law against the United States or its representatives.

Independent agencies are requested to adhere to these directives.

The Director of the Office of Management and Budget shall publish this memorandum in the Federal Register.

STATEMENT FROM THE PRESIDENT
ON SENATE PASSAGE OF JOB TRAINING REFORM LEGISLATION

More than three years ago, I proposed my G.I. Bill for America's Workers to reform our employment and training system for the 21st-century economy. Today, I am very pleased that the Senate passed — with overwhelming bipartisan support — legislation that incorporates the principles articulated in my original proposal. This legislation reforms our job training system so that it works better for America's workers and is more responsive to today's rapidly changing economy. I particularly thank Senators Jeffords, Kennedy, DeWine, and Wellstone for their hard work at getting this legislation passed.

This legislation will fundamentally reform our workforce development system by empowering Americans to gain new skills with a simple skill grant. It also consolidates the tangle of training programs; creates a network of One-Stop Career Centers; increases accountability to ensure results; allows States and communities to tailor programs to locally determined needs; and ensures that business, labor, and community organizations are full partners in system design and quality assurance. It targets vocational and adult education funds to educational agencies and institutions with the greatest need, and to activities that promote program quality. It improves the vocational rehabilitation program by streamlining eligibility determination, improving State planning, and strengthening program accountability. And it includes the Youth Opportunity Areas initiative — which was funded in last year's appropriations process — that will create jobs and opportunity for out-of-school youth in high-poverty areas.

While I have outstanding concerns with both the Senate and House-passed versions of this legislation, I am confident our differences can be resolved quickly in conference. I urge Congress to continue to work in a bipartisan manner and finish the job of reforming our job training system by early this summer.

TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES:

On April 29, 1998, the Contact Group of countries, consisting of the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, France, Italy, and Russia, met in Rome and agreed to take a number of steps regarding the increasingly dangerous situation in Kosovo. This meeting followed previous meetings in London on March 9, 1998, and in Bonn on March 25, 1998, in which the Contact Group set out crucial requirements that were to have been met by Belgrade and the Kosovo Albanian leadership to adopt a framework for dialogue and a stabilization package. The Contact Group decided that, in the event the requirements set forth in the London and Bonn meetings were not met by the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, additional measures involving financial restrictions would be taken against Belgrade.

In the April 29 meeting, the Contact Group determined that the crucial requirements set out in the earlier meetings had not been met by Belgrade and therefore decided to take action to put into effect a freeze on the funds held abroad by the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Republic of Serbia. The countries also decided that if by May 9, 1998, Belgrade's non-compliance was continuing to block dialogue between Belgrade and the Kosovo Albanian leadership, the countries would take action to ban new investment in the Republic of Serbia. The Russian Federation did not associate itself with these measures.

The Contact Group concluded that the current situation in Kosovo was untenable and the risk of an escalating conflict required immediate action. It also found that, if unresolved, the conflict

threatened to spill over to other parts of the region. The United States attaches high priority to supporting the security interests of the neighboring states and to ensuring security of borders. It is also of particular importance that developments in Kosovo should not disrupt progress in implementing the Dayton peace agreement in Bosnia. This threat to the peace of the region constitutes an unusual and extraordinary threat to the national security and foreign policy of the United States.

On May 8, 1998, by the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and laws of the United States of America, including the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.), and section 301 of title 3 of the United States Code, and consistent with the findings of the Contact Group regarding the situation in Kosovo, I declared a national emergency to respond to the unacceptable actions and policies of the Belgrade authorities and issued an Executive Order to implement the measures called for by the Contact Group. That Order freezes the assets of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro that are under U.S. jurisdiction and, in concert with the other Contact Group countries, restricts access to the international financial system. That Order also prohibits new investment by U.S. persons, or their facilitation of other persons' new investment, in Serbia. It is our intent to exempt the Government of Montenegro, by means of licenses, from the prohibitions contained in the Order wherever possible. That government has been included in the Order to ensure effective implementation of sanctions against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, of which the Republic of Montenegro is a constituent part.

The Order that I signed on May 8 carries out these measures by:

- blocking all property, and interests in property, of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro, including the prohibition of financial transactions with, including trade financing for, those governments; and
- prohibiting new investment by U.S. persons, or their facilitation of other persons' new investment, in the territory of the Republic of Serbia, effective May 10.

The May 8 Order provides that the Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Secretary of State, is authorized to take such actions, including the promulgation of rules and regulations, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Order. We intend to license transactions necessary to conduct the official business of the United States Government and the United Nations. We also intend to issue licenses to allow humanitarian, diplomatic, and journalistic activities to continue.

The Secretary of Treasury may terminate, in whole or in part, any of these measures upon notification by the Secretary of State that the imposition of these measures is no longer necessary.

The declaration of national emergency made under Executive Order 12808, and expanded in

Executive Orders 12810 and 12831, remains in effect and is not affected by my May 8 Order.

Executive Order

BLOCKING PROPERTY OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF
THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA, SERBIA, AND MONTENEGRO
AND PROHIBITING NEW INVESTMENT IN SERBIA
IN RESPONSE TO THE SITUATION IN KOSOVO

- - - - -

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, including the International Emergency Economic Powers Act ("IEEPA") (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.), and section 301 of title 3, United States Code, and in view of the decisions taken by the Contact Group in Rome, Italy on April 29, 1998,

I, WILLIAM J. CLINTON, President of the United States of America, find that the actions and policies of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Republic of Serbia with respect to Kosovo by promoting ethnic conflict and human suffering threaten to destabilize countries of the region and to disrupt progress in Bosnia in implementing the Dayton peace agreement, and therefore constitute an unusual and extraordinary threat to the national security and foreign policy of the United States, and hereby declare a national emergency to deal with that threat.

I hereby order:

Sec. 1. (a) Except to the extent provided in section 2 of this order, section 203(b) of IEEPA (50 U.S.C. 1702(b)), and in regulations, orders, directives, or licenses that may hereafter be issued pursuant to this order, all property and interests in property of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro that are in the United States, that hereafter come within the United States, or that are or hereafter come within the possession or control of United States persons, including their overseas branches, are hereby blocked.

(b) The blocking of property and property interests in paragraph (a) of this section includes the prohibition of financial transactions with, including trade financing for, the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro by United States persons.

Sec. 2. Nothing in section 1 of this order shall prohibit financial transactions, including trade financing, by United States persons within the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia if (a) conducted exclusively through the domestic banking system within the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in local currency (dinars), or (b) conducted using bank notes or barter.

Sec. 3. Effective at 12:01 a.m. eastern daylight time on May 10, 1998, except as otherwise provided in regulations, orders, directives, or licenses that may hereafter be issued pursuant to this order, all new investment by U.S. persons in the territory of the Republic of Serbia, and the approval or other facilitation by U.S. persons of other persons' new investment in the territory of the Republic of Serbia, are prohibited unless, prior to that time, the Secretary of State determines otherwise.

Sec. 4. Any transaction by a United States person that evades or avoids, or has the purpose of evading or avoiding, or attempts to violate, any of the prohibitions set forth in this order is prohibited.

Sec. 5. For the purposes of this order:

- (a) The term "person" means an individual or entity;
- (b) The term "entity" means a partnership, association, trust, joint venture, corporation, or other organization;
- (c) The term "new investment" means (i) the acquisition of debt or equity interests in, (ii) a commitment or contribution of funds or other assets to, or (iii) a loan or other extension of credit to, a public or private undertaking, entity, or project, other than donations of funds for purely humanitarian purposes to charitable organizations;

(d) The term "United States person" means any United States citizen, permanent resident alien, juridical person organized under the laws of the United States (including foreign branches), or any person in the United States;

(e) The term "Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia" means the government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, its agencies, instrumentalities, and controlled entities, including all financial institutions and state-owned and socially-owned entities organized or located in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia as of May 8, 1998, any successors to such entities, and their respective subsidiaries and branches, wherever located, and any persons acting or purporting to act for or on behalf of any of the foregoing;

(f) The term "Government of the Republic of Serbia" means the government of the Republic of Serbia, including any subdivisions thereof or local governments therein, its respective agencies, instrumentalities, and controlled entities, including all financial institutions and state-owned and socially-owned entities organized or located in the Republic of Serbia as of May 8, 1998, any successors to such entities, and their respective subsidiaries and branches, wherever located, and any

persons acting or purporting to act for or on behalf of any of the foregoing;

(g) The term "Government of the Republic of Montenegro" means the government of the Republic of Montenegro, including any subdivisions thereof or local governments therein, its respective agencies, instrumentalities and controlled entities, including all financial institutions and state-owned and socially-owned entities organized or located in the Republic of Montenegro as of May 8, 1998, any successors to such entities, and their respective subsidiaries and branches, wherever located, and any persons acting or purporting to act for or on behalf of any of the foregoing.

Sec. 6. The Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Secretary of State, is hereby authorized to take such actions, including the promulgation of rules and regulations, and to employ all powers granted to me by the International Emergency Economic Powers Act, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this order. The Secretary of the Treasury may redelegate any of these functions to other officers and agencies of the United States Government, all agencies of which are hereby directed to take all appropriate measures within their authority to carry out the provisions of this order, including suspension

or termination of licenses or other authorizations in effect as of the date of this order.

Sec. 7. The Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall give special consideration to the circumstances of the Government of the Republic of Montenegro and persons located in and organized under the laws of the Republic of Montenegro in the implementation of this order.

Sec. 8. Nothing contained in this order shall confer any substantive or procedural right or privilege on any person or organization, enforceable against the United States, its agencies or its officers.

Sec. 9. (a) This order is effective immediately, except as otherwise provided in section 3.

(b) This order shall be transmitted to the Congress and published in the Federal Register.
