Dear Majority Leader:

Thank you for your recent letter discussing some of the major challenges facing America as we enter the next century.

In 1992, America had a \$290 billion deficit, the product of budget policies that quadrupled the debt. Today, we have a balanced budget, rising surpluses, and an historic opportunity to work together to pay off the national debt and strengthen Social Security and Medicare. Now more than ever, we must maintain the fiscal discipline that has helped strengthen our economy, fuel record investment, and lower interest rates and mortgage payments for tens of millions of families.

The tax bill passed by Congress would reverse the fiscal discipline that has been absolutely critical to making the American economy the strongest it has been in generations. By cutting taxes now in the face of a growing economy, this plan could well lead to higher interest rates and undercut its own benefits by increasing home mortgage payments, credit card rates, and car loan payments.

The tax bill would spend 100 percent of the non-Social Security surplus creating an impossible budgeting problem. It would require nearly 50 percent cuts in essential government functions, everything from education to air traffic control to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. If Congress were unable or unwilling to make cuts of this magnitude, the clear and predictable consequence of such an untenable tax and budget plan would be to divert hundreds of billions of dollars of the Social Security surpluses from promised debt reduction. At the same time, such a plan would provide no money for Medicare or Social Security solvency, and still require cuts in domestic priorities like education, healthcare, law enforcement, science and technology, the environment, and veterans programs.

The authors of this tax cut continue to minimize its likely consequences by including the implausible legislative assumption that many of the major provisions expire after nine years and all of the provisions are repealed after ten years. This scenario would create uncertainty and confusion for taxpayers, and it is highly unlikely that it would ever be implemented. If the tax cut were continued, its problems would grow even more severe. The tax cut would cost about \$2.7 trillion dollars between 2010 and 2019, just at the time when the baby boomers begin to retire, Medicare becomes insolvent, and Social Security comes under strain. If your tax cut became law, it would leave America permanently in debt.

These are the broad considerations that reinforce my decision to prevent this legislation from becoming law. It would also be irresponsible of me to sign legislation that, as written, would force an automatic cut of \$41 billion in Medicare over 5 years and the eventual complete elimination of \$19 billion in farm safety net programs.

Rather than break our fiscal discipline and threaten growth, we should work together to pay off our national debt, devise a bipartisan plan that modernizes Medicare, and extends the solvency of Social Security. Once we have met these basic obligations, we can meet our needs for military readiness, education and other critical programs, while also giving America's families a tax cut. I look forward to working with you in the coming months to put first things first -- by paying off the national debt, maintaining fiscal discipline, and meeting our fundamental challenges for the future.

As you may know, the President (we) sends out messages for the Jewish holidays, including both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur (yes, separate messages), both of which are coming up shortly. Since we have been pushing our gun control/hate crime/youth violence messages lately and with the terrible events of this year, I thought it would be great if this year's Rosh Hashanah message could mention something that might help motivate the grass roots of the already-supportive Jewish community.

It may not be so hard to find something appropriate to say since Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New year, is really all about reflection upon one's actions for the last year, repenting for what we may have done wrong, and whether we are worthy to be under God's good graces for the next year (or, more precisely, should we be written into the book of life).

While there are some perfect Biblical quotes that I am sure we can all hear the President saying (You shall not hate your brethren in your heart. -Leviticus 19:17; You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against your countrymen. Love your neighbor as yourself.-Leviticus 19:18; The sword came into the world because of justice delayed and justice denied. -Pirkei Avot 5:11), he could also say something more oblique like:

As we reflect upon the past year and the incredulous displays of hate and

violence, we as a nation should look for ways to rededicate ourselves to fighting hate and preventing violence in our communities in the coming year...

or

Regrettably, the Jewish people's strong dedication to civil rights and tolerance, learned from difficult lessons of their own, needs to be redoubled if we are to combat the forces of hate and intolerance that still linger in our society...

I'm no writer but you get the idea. If we can get this done in a timely manner (early in the week of Sept 6 or earlier), I can get this out to thousands of rabbis (and lay people) who will hopefully be inspired enough to raise these issues during the high holidays (when 80% of American Jews actually participate in observances) so we can get some buzz about the President's priorities on violence.

I am happy to help get draft messages or anything else that could help expediate the process. Thanks for your consideration.

Puerto Rican Prisoners Clemency: Senate Terrorism Subcommittee Chairman Paul Coverdell (R-GA) asked you to reconsider commuting the sentences of individuals who have served long jail terms for crimes committed in the name of Puerto Rican independence even though the commutations were conditional. The Fraternal Order of Police launched a campaign against the grant, suggesting New York politics were the motive for it. New York City Mayor Rudolph Giuliani (R) said it was a mistake because the prisoners have not accepted the conditions yet. He also called for Justice Department reports on the cases to be released. His police commissioner held a press conference with officers opposed to the clemency, including three who were injured in bombings committed by the organization most of the prisoners belonged to -- but none of the prisoners committed. The Washington Post, however, said your decision was "appropriate."

Dear Mr. Leader:

Thank you for your recent letter discussing some of the major challenges facing America as we enter the next century.

In 1992, America had a \$290 billion deficit, the product of budget policies that quadrupled the debt. Today, we have a balanced budget, rising surpluses, and an historic opportunity to work together to pay off the national debt and strengthen Social Security and Medicare. Now more than ever, we must maintain the fiscal discipline that has helped strengthen our economy, fuel record investment, and lower interest rates and mortgage payments for tens of millions of families.

The tax bill passed by Congress would reverse the fiscal discipline that has been absolutely critical to making the American economy the strongest it has been in generations. By enacting this risky tax proposal now in the face of a growing economy, this plan could well lead to higher interest rates and undercut any benefits for most Americans by increasing home mortgage payments, credit card rates, and car loan payments.

The tax bill would spend 100 percent of the non-Social Security surplus creating an impossible budgeting problem. It would require nearly 50 percent cuts in essential government functions, everything from education to air traffic control to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. If Congress were unable or unwilling to make cuts of this magnitude, the clear and predictable consequence of such an untenable tax and budget plan would be to divert hundreds of billions of dollars of the Social Security surpluses from promised debt reduction. At the same time, such a plan would provide no money for Medicare or Social Security solvency, and still require cuts in domestic priorities like education, healthcare, law enforcement, science and technology, the environment, and veterans programs.

The authors of this tax cut minimize its likely consequences by relying on an implausible legislative assumption that many of its major provisions expire after nine years and all of the provisions are repealed after ten years. This scenario would create uncertainty and confusion for taxpayers, and it is highly unlikely that it would ever be implemented. If the tax cut were continued, its problems would grow even more severe. The tax cut would cost about \$2.7 trillion dollars between 2010 and 2019, just at the time when the baby boomers begin to retire, Medicare becomes insolvent, and Social Security comes under strain. If your tax cut became law, it would leave America permanently in debt.

These are the broad considerations that reinforce my decision to prevent this legislation from becoming law. It would also be irresponsible of me to sign legislation that, as written, would force an automatic cut of \$41 billion in Medicare over 5 years and the eventual complete elimination of \$19 billion in farm safety net programs.

Rather than break our fiscal discipline and threaten growth, we should work together to pay off our national debt, devise a bipartisan plan that modernizes Medicare, and extends the solvency of Social Security. Once we have met these basic obligations, we can meet our needs for military readiness, education and other critical programs, while also giving America's families a tax cut. I look forward to working with you in the coming months to put first things first -- by paying off the national debt, maintaining fiscal discipline, and meeting our fundamental challenges for the future.

No material change comments were received from DOJ or HHS.

DOJ had wanted a slightly looser research agenda item (task #5), substituting "annually" for the wording asking for specific attention to FY 2001 and prior year funds. I left that part as it was. However, I did make one change from yesterday's version in today's #5. Early in the day, I misunderstood the paper Wei-min sent you that describes the OSTP research coordination activity. I thought it was an operational thing; in fact it is only a potential budget proposal that we may see in the

September 13th submissions. As such, I deleted the words "Building on some interagency work now underway."

I should note, though, that we haven't before considered making the Science Advisor an overt part of this Council. I'm a little puzzled by the Advisor's efforts on youth violence; I wouldn't have thought a lot of value added would come from OSTP on this. I haven't added OSTP to the list of cc's on the directive. They are covered by the catch-all paragraph that begins, "The Chair of the Council may add such other officials as he deems appropriate."

The Health Division again queried Callahan's staff about the role of the Surgeon General. They responded that they understand that S.G. staff are not happy with the changes and are making calls around the White House and OMB, but this is an internal HHS decision and Callahan says they stick by it.

Education has not responded. Mike Cohen was reading it, but left for an event with the Secretary. Modzeleski hasn't responded. If either one sends anything over, I'll pass it along, but they didn't have material changes last time, so I don't expect much today.

Labor had no material changes. Darla once again expressed the hope that something timely would be done with Specter (and other Hill people) at or around the radio address taping, so that the four agency heads would not suffer his wrath at the hearing on the 14th.

Subject: Youth Violence Council

Violence by youth and against youth is an issue that deeply concerns us all. Youth violence can be thought of as a juvenile crime issue, as a mental health issue, and as a school safety issue. It affects every region and demographic group. As many recent incidents have made us aware, it is a problem that can strike with unexpected force – and that now demands uncommonly unified responses.

A number of Federal programs already address many aspects of the youth violence issue. I am proud of the joint efforts of the Attorney General, the Secretary of Health and Human Services, and the Secretary of Education, in developing the Safe Schools/Healthy Students initiative. These agencies also worked well together to help us respond quickly to the

Columbine High School incident. I have read with interest the report of the Attorney General's Coordinating Council on Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. I look forward to the report the Surgeon General is preparing on the causes of youth violence, in response to my May request.

The Secretary of Labor's efforts to address the needs of youth, particularly out-of-school, are also about to bear fruit, as high-poverty communities implement our new Youth Opportunity Grants, and as the Secretary and Attorney General finalize their agreement for cooperative work on those grants and Labor's Youth Offender grant program.

With so many agencies and programs involved, and with the need for this Administration to work closely with so many different elements of State and local government, tribes, schools, community groups, and families, it has become increasingly clear to me that the Federal government needs a more effective policy coordination strategy for youth violence issues.

Therefore, today I direct my Assistant for Domestic Policy, Bruce Reed, to form a White House Council on Youth Violence to provide this policy coordination, to provide flexible and timely responses to the challenge of youth violence, and to ensure that our nation's citizens are able to benefit from the Federal government's many anti-violence initiatives.

Structure of the Council

The Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy will chair the Council. The Director of the Office of Management and Budget will be a regular participant. Four agency heads will be the regular program members of the Council:

- The Attorney General, responding to the juvenile crime aspects.*

- The Secretary of Health and Human Services, responding both to the public health aspects and the family issues;
- The Secretary of Education, responding to the school safety issues.
- The Secretary of Labor, responding to youth employment and out-of-school youth issues.

The Chair of the Council may add such other officials as he deems appropriate to further the purposes of this overall effort or to participate in discussions of specific aspects of it. For example, matters relating to public health aspects would involve the Surgeon General. Matters relating to firearms control or drug abuse would involve the Secretary of Treasury and the Director of National Drug Control Policy, respectively. Implications for economic development policies would call for involvement of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, the Secretary of Agriculture, and the Secretary of Commerce. Comparable policies for Indian country would engage the Secretary of the Interior. Issues relating to community service opportunities for youth would involve the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation for National and Community Service.

The Chair, after consultation with Council members, will appoint staff members to coordinate efforts of the Council. The Chair may call upon the participating agencies for logistical support to the Council, as necessary.

Duties of the Council

1. Develop a citizen's information hub. The Council will develop and maintain a coordinated inventory of relevant agency programs, and provide analyses of their effectiveness. It will make this inventory widely available in summary form, and upon request in more detail, through the services of a Council member, to elected officials, community groups, police organizations, school systems, parents, and others working on local solutions to these issues. The inventory and full texts of program reports and evaluations should be available on an easily accessible website. The availability of this compilation will be widely publicized.

On August 17, 1999, I announced that a non-profit, non-partisan "National Campaign Against Youth Violence" had been established to bring together all segments of society to help prevent youth violence. The Council will consult with the National Campaign to learn about its activities and to benefit from what the Campaign learns from communities across the Nation.

2. Produce reports on youth violence. The Council will write or commission reports on various aspects of the problem of youth violence, describing, for instance, best practices in combating the problem. In addition, the Surgeon General is now carrying out a broad study of the potential causes of youth violence. I ask that the Surgeon General consult closely with the Council in the development of the study, so that I may have the benefit of participation of all the involved agencies in its analysis and findings.

3. Expand the Safe Schools/Healthy Students model of collaboration. This initiative of the Departments of Justice, Education, and Health and Human Services has evolved into a highly effective collaboration among the agencies.

The Council will oversee this effort and examine options for improving its operations and applying the model to other governmental efforts. The Secretary of Labor will begin participation in the initiative through establishing linkages to Youth Opportunities and Youth Offender grants.

4. Provide tools for parents to deal with the issue. Many Federal programs address issues relating to strengthening the family and helping parents raise children. The Council will explore the possibility of devising a cross-program strategy to help parents address youth violence. It will also report on new tools emerging in both the private and public sectors to assist parents.

5. Coordinate the federal research agenda. The Council will oversee coordination of agency research agendas and the development of needed cross-agency research collaborations. I ask the Council to seek to have this structure in place to guide the planning for and obligation of FY 2001 research funds, and where feasible, to improve the planned use of funds available from prior years.

6. Develop further policy responses. The Council will meet at the call of the Chair, to discuss new findings from analyses of the youth violence issue and to consider new or modified Administration responses to it, especially those that involve more than one agency. Recommendations for initiatives will be discussed in the Council for consistency with overall coordinated policy, before being presented for formal decision in the budget process. From time to time, the Council will report to me directly on the results of its efforts.

On Thursday September 9th, the Children Affected by AIDS Foundation will host a premier of a documentary on the impact of the AIDS epidemic on the children in Africa. The documentary, which was produced by Rory Kennedy, was filmed during the Presidential Mission to Africa that resulted in the Report to the President that was released in mid July in conjunction with the announcement of the Administration's new \$100 million African Initiative.

More than 50 Members of the House and Senate have confirmed their attendance at the event. Speakers include Senators Hatch, Leahy, Kennedy and Specter and Congresspersons Gillman and Kilpatrick, Rory Kennedy, Archbishop Desmond Tutu and myself. Dear Speaker Hastert,

This week, the House of Representatives will have an historic opportunity to strengthen our democracy when it considers legislation to reform our campaign finance system. I write to you today to urge the passage of the bipartisan campaign finance reform bill offered by Representatives Christopher Shays and Martin Meehan.

The Shays-Meehan legislation represents real, comprehensive reform. It would ban the raising of unregulated "soft money" by both parties, address backdoor campaign spending by outside organizations, and strengthen public disclosure. It would revitalize the political process by curbing the role of special interests, giving voters a louder voice, and treating incumbents and challengers of both parties fairly.

For three years I have challenged Congress to pass the Shays-Meehan bill. As you know, it was approved by the House last year, only to be blocked by a minority of the Senate. Today, I ask Members of the House to pass this long overdue legislation – and without unnecessary amendments that would undermine its intent and reach.

We have had enough talk about reform; the House of Representatives now has a rare and fleeting opportunity to act. The American people know the system needs fixing – but many have come to doubt Congress's will to fix it. I urge you to make this the year that Congress proves the cynics wrong, and passes bipartisan, comprehensive campaign finance reform.
