Lesbian Calif. pol predicts that ballot initiative will lose if gays can organize

SAN DIEGO - The state ballot initiative to ban gay marriage will fail on March 7, says openly lesbian state Assemblymember Sheila James Kuehl, D-Santa Monica.

Kuehl was in San Diego Jan. 22 to raise money for her state Senate campaign. Term limits prevent her from running for the Assembly again.

"I think we're going to defeat the Knight initiative," Kuehl said. "There's been great organizing in northern and southern California. The most promising thing is that the more that people know about it, in polling or

in long sort of question interviews, the less likely they are to support it. So that tells us that if we get the word out, people will be less likely to support it."

The initiative, formally known as Proposition 22, gets its nickname from its sponsor, state Sen. Pete Knight, R-Palmdale.

"The No On Knight organization needs half a million dollars from San Diego," Kuehl said. "If there's anyone who reads this [article], anyone who knows anyone who reads this, anyone who has not given money to No On Knight, they should give at least \$50 right away, and more and more and more if they can, because the other side is pouring millions of dollars in and there's only six weeks left till the election, and it's very important. And that's what it takes. It takes money to buy advertising, do mailers and send out tapes for house parties."

Several measures that gay activists had long sought passed the California legislature in 1999 - including a domestic- partnership registration scheme, a beefed-up statewide ban on anti-gay discrimination, and a ban on anti-gay discrimination in schools - but Kuehl says there's still plenty to do.

"There will be some interest in increasing the number of benefits that you gain by registering as a domestic partner," she said. "There will be some attention still paid to AIDS research and treatment funding. I think we'll need to look at whether we need to do something to implement both AB 1001 [the gay-rights law] and AB 537 [the schools discrimination ban]. They have to issue regulations in those agencies and we haven't seen them yet. So we're going to have to push on that."

Kuehl was a TV star in the late 1950s and early 1960s. She played Jackie Erwin on *Trouble With Father* and Zelda Gilroy on *The Many Loves of Dobie Gillis*. Her acting career came to an abrupt halt when network officials found out she was gay. Kuehl went on to become Associate Dean of Students at UCLA. Later she graduated from Harvard Law School, taught law at UCLA, and founded the California Women's Law Center.

Gays for Gore canvas New Hampshire

The YouGoGore team headed for New Hampshire in late January with its gaydar humming. The 20-member crew's goal was to recruit hundreds of GLBT voters for
Al Gore's presidential campaign before the New Hampshire primary Feb. 1.

YouGoGore's gaydar went off even before the 20-member crew, mostly from Washington, D.C., and sporting pink triangle Gore campaign buttons on their jackets, left the Manchester, N.H., airport. "We were stopped by 10 people who inquired about the buttons," said YouGoGore founder Paul Yandura. "So we gave our buttons away in exchange for names and phone numbers."

Yandura, who worked for the Clinton/Gore campaign in 1996 and then served as a political appointee in the Clinton administration before returning to school, is a staunch Gore supporter. "I've been in Washington for five years and Gore has been there for us," he said.

Several weeks ago, Yandura met in Washington with several other gay and lesbian Gore backers and they decided to go to New Hampshire to work for their candidate. The team spent more than a week canvassing neighborhoods, searching for rainbow flags on porches and rainbow stickers on windows.

They went into GLBT bars and promoted Gore's record. They mailed 1,000 YouGoGore newsletters to voters. They drew about 100 gays and lesbians to a rally at the Front Runner, a private GLBT club in Manchester. And they just couldn't let the shoddy decor at campaign headquarters go. "We redecorated," Yandura said. "We were hanging streamers and signs. We even vacuumed." By the weekend before the primary, YouGoGore had sought support from more than 2,000 GLBT voters in New Hampshire.

"We all just believed in the vice president enough to do it," said Yandura, who postponed studies to canvass in the Granite State for his candidate. "We're all volunteers. We're up here staying on our own dime. We recognize the importance of the gay vote."

The GLBT voting bloc, according to a 1996 election survey, is 5 percent, about the size of the Latino block and slightly larger than the Jewish vote.

"I think the candidates recognize the importance of our community in terms of the numbers we represent," said longtime GLBT civil rights advocate Virginia Apuzzo.

"The Republicans are trying to temper their rhetoric and the Democrats obviously are keenly aware of the importance of our community in any victory." Apuzzo was the highest ranking gay or lesbian in the Clinton White House until she became the chair for leadership in public policy at the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force Policy Institute last year and began focusing on the 2000 presidential races.

Going into the New Hampshire primary, Apuzzo was hoping Gore and Republican George W. Bush would not emerge from their contests with decisive victories over Bradley in the Democratic Party and moderate John McCain in the Republican Party. "When the field is winnowed out, the less opportunity there will be for debate and dialogue," said Apuzzo, who has not declared support for any presidential candidate. "If we come out with solid Gore and Bush victories, that closes down our opportunity to use the election as a leverage to promote an understanding of our issues. Frontrunners sometimes get apathetic," she continued.

On the Democratic side, Apuzzo said a lengthy primary fight would provide time to press Gore and Bradley to support legalized same-sex marriage and other issues. Gore might also be motivated to press Clinton for new White House initiatives, including support for anti-violence programs and education programs at GLBT community centers. "Al Gore, as the sitting vice president, can do a lot in the next year," she said. "You don't have to go to Congress for everything."

On the Republican side, Kevin Ivers, of the national Log Cabin Republicans, also hopes for a prolonged primary bout. "Iowa was the beauty contest. New Hampshire is the first round of the main event," Ivers said. "I think the best thing for the gay community is for McCain to come out of New Hampshire with a big victory and then go into South Carolina with some momentum. Pat Robertson and Ralph Reed are waiting down there and they're supporting George Bush." Primaries in Arizona, where McCain was leading Bush by 7 percentage points last week, and Michigan, where Bush was way ahead at press time, follow the vote in South Carolina.

But perhaps the biggest post-New Hampshire event is Super Tuesday, with March 7 primaries in Connecticut, Georgia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Missouri, New York, Ohio, Rhode Island, Vermont and California. "The world will change dramatically March 7," Ivers said. "And California will be the motherlode."

If the primary season does become a long one, Yandura said YouGoGore will likely head to other states. "California and New York have their organizations, but we know there are places we can go to do outreach, to make inroads," he said.

opinion has remained largely unchanged on the issue because voters tend to stick with their initial reactions on issues that are not complex.

"The public understands it and has deep, visceral feeling about the issue," he said. "How people view marriage and how they feel about homosexuality are gut reactions."

Several groups clearly tend to favor the measure, according to the poll's data. Of the people who can be classified as the "religious right," 86 percent support the initiative.

Seventy-two percent of Republicans favor the measure, and Protestants and Catholics, who together represent about two-thirds of the state's voters, are inclined to support it by a wide margin.

"Over the years, nontraditional families have been gaining tolerance," Field said. "But that is not the same as acceptance. The public doesn't want to discriminate against gays and lesbians, so they are willing to allow partnerships. But the idea of a marriage is something else."

The San Francisco Bay Area is the only region in the state where most people do not support Proposition 22 -- 51 percent said they would vote no, and only 38 percent said they would vote yes.

There is not much of a difference in degree of support among different ethnicities. Fifty-four percent of Latinos favor the proposition, compared with 52 percent of white, non-Latinos and 50 percent of other ethnicities.

The Yes side has been targeting Latinos, running commercials in Spanish even before English-language ads were on the air.

One possible hopeful note for opponents of the measure is that historically, initiatives singling out gays and lesbians have enjoyed leads in pre-election polls, only to lose on election day.

This was true for a 1976 initiative that required the firing of gay teachers, a 1986 initiative that sought the isolation and quarantine of AIDS patients and 1988's Proposition 102 that would have required doctors and blood banks to report all AIDS cases to health officials.

Field said opinions may change in the weeks leading up to the election, as television commercials and the media start highlighting the issue.

The Field Poll was conducted February 2-6 among a representative sample of 1,186 registered voters and has a margin of error of 3.6 percent. The poll represents a snapshot of voter sentiment at the time it was conducted and is not intended to be a prediction of the election outcome.

PROPOSITION 22

Knight Initiative Exposes Deep Divisions in Electorate

STATE -- It's the measure on the March ballot with the most potential to polarize voters: Proposition 22, which makes a marriage legal only if it's between a man and a woman.

At first glance, the initiative seems merely to confirm the obvious: People of the same sex cannot get married in California or anywhere else in the nation.

But Proposition 22 spokesman Robert Glazier said the measure is designed to preserve the status quo and protect traditional marriage from "a very small group of millionaire gay activists and special-interest groups whose agenda is to radically redefine marriage for an entire society."

Language defining marriage would be added to the state's Family Code. Supporters of the proposition frame it as a states-rights issue. Why, they argue, should judges in Vermont -- who ruled recently that gays are entitled to the same marriage benefits as heterosexuals -- define marriage for Californians?

Opponents, however, say that underneath the rhetoric that is careful not to bash gays lies an attempt to turn back the clock on gay rights.

Despite its explosive potential, the marriage initiative has remained fairly steady in the polls, about a 5-to-4 ratio in support, with very few undecided.

Still, the measure certainly has created some strange bedfellows.

Lesbian rock 'n' roller Melissa Etheridge and conservative Republican University of California regent Ward Connerly are against it. Connerly's opposition is based on his view that government should not intrude on people's private lives.

The ultra-right Eagle Forum favors the measure, as does Julio Calderon, former president of the Mexican-American Political Association. The Yes on Proposition 22 campaign is making its appeals primarily to conservative and Latino voters. Its first TV commercial shows an extended Latino family celebrating a grandparent's wedding anniversary.

Opponents believe the measure threatens dozens of local and state laws that grant domestic-partner benefits, hospital visitation rights and adoption of children by lesbian or gay couples. Critics point out the measure's original big donors -- such as Orange County banking heir Howard Ahmanson -- support some of the most virulently anti-gay organizations in the state. For six years, Ahmanson was a trustee of and major contributor to the Chalcedon Institute, whose founder advocates the death penalty for gays.

"Those who take issue with the word 'marriage' when applied to people of the same sex need to discern the subtext of this divisive and polarizing initiative," wrote the Rev. Alan Jones, dean of Grace Cathedral in San Francisco, in a piece opposing the measure. "I know of gay couples who've had to resort to one adopting the other as a means of ensuring civil and legal protection of their committed relationships. What then is at issue here? Civil rights, plain and simple. Marriage needs neither defense nor definition."

The measure's sponsor, state Sen. William J. "Pete" Knight, a

Republican from Palmdale and a former fighter pilot, has been keeping a low profile since October. His gay son, David Knight, also an ex-fighter pilot, wrote an op-ed piece in the Los Angeles Times on October 14, implying that his father was motivated by a failure to accept his son's homosexuality.

The elder Knight has not spoken to his son for three years, since David Knight told him he was gay, the younger Knight wrote. He said his father, who also had a gay brother who died of AIDS, has exhibited a "blind, uncaring, uninformed, knee-jerk reaction to a subject about which he knows nothing and wants to know nothing, but which serves his political career."

Proposition 22 supporters say the initiative is not about Pete Knight or his son or about taking away anyone's right to a same-sex relationship. They say it merely codifies what most politicians and 700,000 signers of Knight's initiative petition believe: that the role of marriage between men and women is irreplaceable.

Although the subject is civil marriage, organized religion got involved in the campaign early. Last fall, the Mormon Church in Utah exhorted members to give money and become active in the campaign. The California Catholic Conference of Bishops soon followed. Then, the Interfaith Clergy Task Force, based in Northern California, began a counterattack and is planning a "Solidarity Sabbath" this weekend for "prayer and protest" against the initiative.

The pro-Proposition 22 campaign has raised about twice as much as the opposition -- almost \$5 million, compared with \$2.25 million.
