Dear Mr. Chairman:

This is in response to your request for the views of the Department
of Transportation (DOT) on H.R. 2552, a bill

"To require that all Government records that contain
information bearing on the last flight and disappearance of
Amelia Earhart be transmitted to the Library of Congress and
made available to the public."

At the outset, I note that the Department has no objection to this
proposal. As to the specific questions raised in your letter of
October 4, we have conducted a survey of records maintained by
various offices within the Department and the Federal Aviation
Administration (FAA). We specifically surveyed the DOT Offices of
International Aviation and Information Resource Management.
Additionally, we surveyed the Office of the Assistant
Administrator for Information Technology, the Civil Aviation
Registry in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, the Office of Accident
Investigation, and the Associate Administrator for Air Traffic at
the FAA.

We have determined that airman records for Amelia Earhart no longer
exist. The only documents pertaining to Amelia Earhart on file
are a carbon copy of her Transport Pilot License, and a microfilm
copy of an index card indicating she is deceased. A complete
pilot file for Frederick J. Noonan, however, is currently
maintained on microfilm at the FAA's Civil Aviation Registry in
Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Also located at the Registry is a file
containing the ownership history information on Amelia Earhart's
aircraft, the Lockheed 10E she was flying when she disappeared.
It has been our policy to make these documents public upon
request. We have been unable to locate any other records relating
to Amelia Earhart or Frederick J. Noonan, or, in particular,
material associated with their last flight.
