Dear Mr. President:

I was pleased to receive your letter dated 8 July, 2000 concerning the two recently signed agreements between Saudi Arabia and both the Yemen Arab Republic and Kuwait, in addition to the question of oil and the Camp David Summit.

The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia has always endeavored to work for peace and stability in our region, and exhausts all efforts, whether diplomatic, material or otherwise, in order to achieve our objectives.

We look upon border disputes as one of the main causes of instability between neighbors, which should always be settled in a spirit of fairness and mutual interest of the respective States. We are therefore hopeful that these agreements will set a precedence and model for other States in our region to end their border disputes.

With reference to my country's current oil policy, please be assured that we have always taken into account the importance of market stability and the interests of both producer and consumer. This is supported by the fact that Saudi Arabia has recently announced its intention to increase production in order to maintain stability of the oil market.

Regarding the current Camp David Summit; We know that you fully understand the importance and sensitivity of the issues being discussed in the current round of negotiations between the Palestinians and Israelis, particularly the question of Jerusalem, which is not only of singular importance to Arabs, but to Muslims all over the world. I am sure that you will agree that the success and future of the peace process depends entirely on the fate of Jerusalem, and I am confident that you are aware of the importance of not subjecting the Palestinian side to undue pressure, in order to accept agreements that we know in advance, the impossibility of them being implemented, whether on the Palestinian or Arab side.

We are of the opinion that what should be stressed in these negotiations, is the upholding of the basic principles of the peace process, in accordance with resolutions of international legality and the text of the agreements already ratified between the two parties.

Mr. President, please accept the assurances of my highest consideration.
