FOR JIM FROM RICK HOLTZAPPLE:

1) Timing of Foreign Ministerial: The Sous-Sherpas have still been unable to reach agreement, even after considerable discussion at their last meeting. U.S. left that meeting believing the likely dates were June 8-9. But then others began pushing for something in the May 28-30 timeframe, and the Germans suggested the option of June 12-13 as well. They still have no agreement. (Albright could do June 12-13, but has conflicts with on May 28-30). This will have to be discussed again by Political Directors when they meet Feb. 26-27.

2) Revised German Discussion Papers: Gretschmann's office has confirmed to me that they will not be sending out any revised papers before receiving comments from others. I have told State to polish up what they have done in response to your request to compile possible deliverables on the globalization theme (with input from Treasury and Labor), and send it over. The Education paper has been redrafted and is with Elena Kagan for a final review before showing to you.
