Together with our NATO allies, we are determined to save innocent lives, to protect peace and stability in Europe and to forcefully and unmistakably let it be known that we will not tolerate the persecution of innocent people because of their race, religion or ethnic background.

I am encouraged by the growing international support for this operation, the magnificent performance of the men and women prosecuting the air campaign and providing for the refugees together with the generosity millions world wide have shown for the plight of the hundreds of thousands of displaced Kosovar civilians.

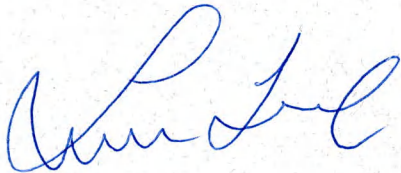
