Dear Mr. President:

On April 19, you submitted a \$6 billion emergency funding request to the Congress. As stated in your proposal, these additional funds would be used primarily to finance military operations in the Kosovo area through September 30 of this year.

We understand and appreciate the difficult decisions you must make with respect to our ongoing operations in the Kosovo area. In the spirit of working together to meet America's interests at home and abroad, Mr. President, we ask three things of you today:

- First, we ask you to clearly articulate to this Congress and to the American people the funding method you believe should be used to finance this request.
- Second, we implore you not to ask us to use America's Social Security surplus to fund this request.
- Third, we strongly request that you specifically enumerate cuts you believe can be made in current spending to offset your proposal.

We in the Congress are faced with this funding proposal because of your administration's actions in Kosovo. We need not remind you that these actions carry with them many burdens – one of which is the question of how they will be funded. We call on you to be honest with the American public and clearly enunciate the funding method you expect to be used to finance extended operations in the Kosovo area.

You have long argued for setting aside much of the Social Security surplus. We have agreed with that sentiment and have taken steps to "lock up" all of that surplus for preserving Social Security and Medicare. If you now believe the Congress should use a portion of the Social Security surplus to fund this emergency spending, you have an obligation to make that clear to the American people. If you believe the Congress should cut spending in other areas to offset the funding needed to fulfill your request, we ask that you specify which areas you think should be reduced.

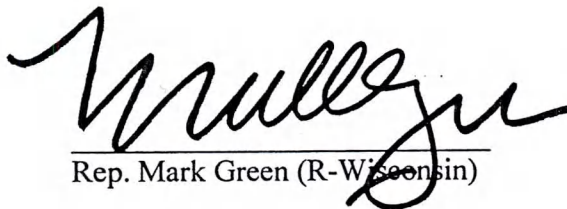
In our opinion, the best course of action is to fund these operations through offsets. We believe Social Security dollars should be used *solely* for Social Security – not for funding additional Kosovo operations.

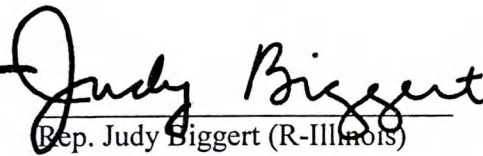
Without offsets, this spending request in its current form will have a great deal of difficulty generating support in this Congress – perhaps more than you now realize. Many of us have worked hard to ensure the federal government does not use Social Security dollars to fund anything but Social Security. This emergency funding proposal, without assurances that our three conditions above will be met, may put much of that work at risk.

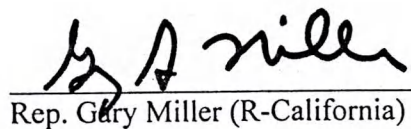
Each of us know and fully understand the tremendous difficulties the United States currently faces in the Kosovo area, Mr. President. Nevertheless, we stand united in our resolve to protect Social Security.

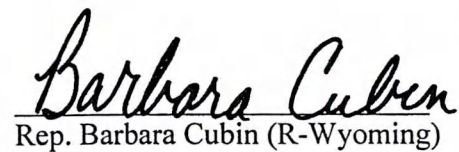
